Itinerary

Day 1: Arrive to Cairo Airport

Welcome to Cairo, Egypt!

Upon your arrival at <u>Cairo International Airport</u>, a friendly tour leader from Cairo Top Tours will be eagerly awaiting your arrival at the luggage belt. Look for a signboard displaying your name along with our company's logo. Your personal driver and a comfortable, private, air-conditioned vehicle will be ready to transfer you to your Cairo hotel.

Upon reaching the hotel, our dedicated tour leader will assist you with a smooth check-in process and take the time to review your Egypt tour itinerary. This ensures that you are well-prepared for the upcoming days of your Egypt Day Tours.

Rest well in <u>Cairo</u> for the night, and to kick off your journey, we'll be delighted to serve you a refreshing welcome drink!

Day 2 : Pyramids and the highlights of Cairo Tour

Take your nice breakfast at your hotel in the early morning, then get ready to be accompanied by your Egyptologist guide to the Giza Plateau and enjoy the <u>tour to Giza Pyramids</u> of <u>Cheops</u> of the <u>fourth dynasty</u>, built over 4500 years ago by the hands of 100,000 men and it is considered the largest between the 3 Pyramids of Giza. Behind it, you will see the pyramids of his son Chephren and the third pyramid of King Mycerinus, <u>The Great Sphinx</u> made by king Chephren to be the guardian of the necropolis, and the only (almost intact) surviving Valley Temple which is part of Chephren's pyramid complex in Giza at the end of your <u>Giza pyramids tour</u>.

You will go to the oldest part in Cairo to enjoy an amazing <u>Coptic Cairo tour</u> and visit <u>The Hanging</u> <u>Church</u>, which was built above the ruins of the old Fortress of Babylon, the church of St Sergius or Abu Serga church, in addition to Ben Ezra Synagogue, which was a Coptic church before it was converted into a Jewish synagogue in 882 A.D. Take a rest while having your lunch served in an oriental restaurant. After that, we will resume Cairo day tours to <u>The Egyptian Museum</u>, which was opened in 1902 as the first antiquities museum in Cairo. The museum houses artifacts from all periods in the <u>history of Egypt</u> between great statues and huge sarcophagi to the tiniest accessories used by ancient Egyptians.

Finally, you will be taken to the oldest bazaar in Cairo for an unusual Cairo shopping tour experience in the market of <u>Khan El Khalili</u> which is one of the most visited sites during the <u>Islamic Cairo trips.</u>

You will be transferred back to the hotel and overnight in Cairo.

Day 3: Cairo to Bahariya Oasis

At approximately 6:00 AM, begin your day with a hearty breakfast before checking out of your accommodation, as you prepare to embark on your <u>Egypt Desert Safari Trips</u> Adventure. As the day unfolds, you'll embark on a thrilling adventure, ascending the Black Mountain aboard a 4wheel drive vehicle, all in time to witness the mesmerizing sunset. At the summit, you'll explore the ruins, including the famous "English House," while soaking in the picturesque view of Bahariya Oasis as the sun dips below the horizon.

Your day will conclude with a comfortable overnight stay in Bahariya, where you'll enjoy breakfast, lunch, and dinner as part of your package.

Day 4: White & Black Desert

As the day comes to a close, prepare for a unique experience – spending the night amidst the pristine beauty of the White Desert. Camp between the striking white limestone and chalk formations of the western desert, and witness the awe-inspiring moon and stars above.

To complete this memorable day, savor a delicious Bedouin dinner in the heart of the desert.

Day 5: Farafra & Dakhla Oases

Start your day with a delightful breakfast prepared by local experts, complemented by the popular morning tea infused with mint. Your journey continues as you make your way to the enchanting <u>Farafra Oasis</u>. Here, you'll have the opportunity to relax and rejuvenate in the soothing sulfur hot water spring of Bir Setah, also known as Setah Well.

While in Farafra, don't miss the chance to visit the one-of-a-kind mud brick museum curated by the local artist Badr. Explore the historic charm of the old town of Al Qasr before embarking on a scenic 3-hour drive from Farafra to Dakhla.

In Dakhla, you'll uncover the Roman Temple of Deir El Hagar, a magnificent structure partially buried by sand dunes and dating back to the 26th dynasty. This temple bears the legacy of legendary Roman Emperors.

Discover some of Egypt's most exquisite rock-cut tombs at the Roman burial ground of El Muzawwaqqa. After a satisfying lunch, visit the ancient Islamic Village of Al Qasr, which traces its origins back to the twelfth century A.D. Wander through narrow alleys lined with ancient houses, explore historical sites such as the old oil press, the wheat grinder, the old court, and even a medieval prison. Additionally, you'll encounter an old school and an Ayyubid mosque.

As the afternoon unfolds, unwind by a pool-like hot spring and soak in the serene surroundings. Then, venture into the verdant Dakhla farms, where golden sand dunes stretch beneath the clear blue sky. Witness the breathtaking sunset on the Edge of the Great Sand Sea while enjoying a flavorful Bedouin tea.

Your night will be spent at the Desert Lodge Hotel in Dakhla, situated atop a cliff, offering panoramic views of the green village and the renowned rose mountains that <u>Dakhla Oasis</u> is celebrated for.

Day 6 : Kharga Oasis

Today's adventure takes you to the <u>Kharga Oasis</u>. Start your day with a satisfying breakfast as you prepare for an exploration of Dakhla Oasis. Your journey commences with a visit to Qasr El Labkha, a

Roman fortress situated along the historic caravan route known as the famous 40 Days Road, which once linked Egypt with Sudan (DARB EL ARBEIN). Delve into history at the Kharga Museum.

Continue your expedition with a visit to the Roman Temple of Hibis and Nadura, observing these ancient treasures from the outside. Explore Bagawat, renowned as the world's oldest Christian cemetery, where chapels adorned with biblical murals from the Old Testament still retain their vibrant colors.

Next on your itinerary is the charming Baris Oasis, the smallest and most picturesque of <u>the Western</u> <u>Desert Oases</u>. Discover the Temple of Dush, standing proudly amidst a flourishing settlement that once guarded the forty days road during its operation. You'll have the opportunity to observe the wellpreserved details of this Roman settlement, including mud-brick houses, a fortress, and the Temple dedicated to <u>lsis</u> and Serapis.

As the day draws to a close, relish the experience of camping amidst the golden sand dunes of Kharga, where you'll be surrounded by the tranquility of the desert.

Day 7: Kharga \ Luxor (East Bank)
