Day 1 : Cairo Arrival

Our tour guide will be waiting for you with a signboard with your name when you arrive at Cairo International Airport.

In an air-conditioned private vehicle, Cairo Top Tours' tour leader will drive you to your hotel. He will help you check in quickly and easily and then work with you to amend your travel package schedule in Egypt to include the times of the optional tours and pick-up times for everyday.

Day 2: Memphis Tour, Saqqara, and the Giza Pyramids

Following a delicious breakfast at your Cairo hotel, you will meet your Egyptologist guide in the early morning and start your incredible Cairo Day Tours to the Giza Plateau, where you will see:

Cheops's Great Pyramid:

You will learn today how the pyramids were constructed. and you will discover that one of the most ancient marvels of the ancient world, which once stood at 147 meters in height, now only fills 230 square meters.

the Chephren and Mycerinus pyramids:

These were also Khufu's successors as kings and rulers of Egypt during the fourth dynasty, having built the Great Pyramid.

The Sphinx

Take one of our Egypt Classic Tours to see the magnificent statue of a man with a lion's head that has stood here for over 45 centuries. You can also learn about mummification in ancient Egypt by standing in front of the Valley Temple. A panoramic tour that takes in the entire set of Giza pyramids in a picturesque setting is also included in the tour. It's time for some challenging shots now, which you can easily take with your tour guide's assistance. During the tour to the Giza Pyramids, you can take an optional 15-minute camel ride

around the monuments.

After stopping for lunch at Egyptian local restaurant, your driver and tour guide will transport you to Memphis:

Visit the outdoor museum, which is renowned for housing the second-largest alabaster Sphinx in the world, constructed from 80 tons of marble blocks, and the enormous statue of Ramses II that has fallen. Alexandria was the capital of the pharaohs for a millennium and a significant religious and cultural hub for the entire three millennia of ancient Egyptian civilization.

Return to your lodging and spend the night in Cairo.

Day 3: Travel to Luxor and Take Trips There

After having breakfast at the hotel, at 3:30 am After that, make your way to Cairo International Airport to board your trip to Luxor. After being welcomed and helped by a local agent from Cairo Top Tours, you will start your full-day tour of Luxor's west bank of the Nile Valley as follows:

A Valley of Kings Where are you going to study about the evolution of the Egyptian royal tomb following the Pharaohs' removal from the Pyramids as a result of tomb robbery?

The Memnon Colossi This depicts the Pharaoh on a massive scale, sitting in front of his funerary temple on the thrones of Upper and Lower Egypt.

Proceed with your Luxor day trips to view the Queen Hatshepsut Temple:

The Arabs dubbed it The Temple of Deir El Bahari, and it was constructed by one of the greatest builders of antiquity.

We will also take you on an enjoyable tour of the East Bank of Luxor, where you will see the Karnak Temple complex:

In ancient Egypt, that was regarded as the most significant religious complex.

Check in late and get some rest before going to the Temples of Luxor:

You will see the pillared courtyard where the Luxor cachette was found and the granite statues of Ramses II, where the lights inside the temple create a unique atmosphere at night, before being returned to your hotel.

Day 4: Tour of Cairo City

Resuming your Egypt Classic Tours schedule after breakfast. The Treasures of the Golden Pharaoh Tutankhamen, the only royal treasure discovered intact, and the largest collection of Egyptian antiquities in the world can be found at the Egyptian Museum, which your representative will pick you up from your hotel to take to your flight back to Cairo and start your day trip from the airport.

Following that, we will take you to the Saladin Citadel, which houses the Mohamed Ali Alabaster Mosque. Constructed on a high plateau, the citadel was used to garrison Cairo throughout the Islamic era because of its advantageous location. A bird's-eye perspective of Islamic Cairo is available, containing domes, minarets, and mosques that are hundreds or even more years old.

Continue your tour of Coptic Cairo to see the old Roman castle of Babylon and the Virgin Mary-dedicated Hanging Church, which is hanging over the city's historic bastions. Constructed in the 7th century, the official palace of the Coptic patriarchs was transformed into this building in the 11th century. See the St. Sergius Church, which has a crypt where the Holy Family resided for about three months, as well as the spring where they obtained their water supply. Next, we will go to the Ben Ezra Synagogue, which is purported to be the location of the pharaoh's palace where Moses' basket was taken from the Nile.

We will begin our Islamic Cairo tour after lunch, exploring the real walls and gates of this ancient city whose streets date back to the tenth century. The stroll concludes with tea at Fishawy, the oldest cafe in Khan El Khalili. Cairo's historic bazaar.

Enter the hotel and stay the night in Cairo.
