<u>Itinerary</u>

Day 1: Cairo Arrival

Warm regards from Cairo! When you arrive at Cairo International Airport, our tour guide will be waiting for you with a sign bearing your name, ready to help you with all the necessary formalities as you start your trip to Egypt. You will take your air-conditioned car from the airport to your accommodation.

Once you arrive at the hotel, our tour Leader will help you check in smoothly and go over the itinerary with you to confirm the pick-up timings for each tour in your Egypt travel package.

Spend the night in Cairo

Day 2: Memphis, Saqqara, and the Giza Pyramids

After having breakfast at the hotel, begin your day trip to Saggara, Memphis, and the Giza Pyramids.

You will go with our tour guide to the Giza pyramids to view the Great Pyramid of Cheops as well as the pyramids of Mycerinus and Chephren. Next, pay homage to the Great Sphinx, the head of the Pharaoh, and the body of a lion, which represent the might and wisdom of the monarch, and travel to King Chephren's Valley Temple, where his royal remains were mummified prior to being buried. You will learn about the many stages of the mummification procedure from your guide.

Lunchtime is coming! You will be taken to see the Step Pyramid of King Zoser in Sakkara, which is thought to be the earliest man-made structure totally constructed of stone in the entire world, after stopping to eat lunch at a reputable restaurant (Djoser Pyramid). You will also see the Kagemni tomb, one of the nobles' tombs at Sakkara owned by King Teti's son-in-law, and the pyramid of Teti, which has the most spectacular interior of all the accessible pyramids of Egypt (no additional ticket required). Here, you can see scenes from daily life in ancient Egypt, with all of its activities painted and inscribed on the tombs' walls and corridors.

Following that, we'll take you to Memphis to see the outdoor museum. Memphis is only 20 minutes away from Saqqara and features an exhibition of statues and artifacts that remain from the pharaohs' ancient capital, such as the enormous statue of Ramses II and the alabaster sphinx made from an 80,000-ton block of marble.

After your trip is over, you will be returned to your hotel for the night.

Day 3: Visit to the Islamic and Coptic Museums in Cairo

You will be picked up from your hotel by our knowledgeable tour guide from Cairo Top Tours to begin your tour of the Egyptian Museum and Coptic Cairo. A transfer to the Egyptian Museum of Antiquities will occur. to take in the largest collection of ancient Egyptian antiquities and take a trip through the rich history of ancient Egypt The highlights of the more than 250,000 masterpieces on show, including King Tutankhamen's jewels, will be thoroughly discussed by your Egyptologist tour guide, the sole intact royal treasure found, which is a vast collection of gold and jewelry that was kept concealed under the sand for more than 3,000 years until the tomb's excavation in 1922, at which point it was relocated altogether to Cairo and the Egyptian Museum.

Your tour guide will take you on a tour of the Old Cairo District, where you will see the Salah El Din Citadel and the Alabaster Mosque of Mohamed Ali inside. The Alabaster Mosque is a unique example of Ottoman architecture in Cairo, as its design is a reinterpretation of the well-known Blue Mosque in Istanbul. The Citadel was established by Salah Edin and served as the center of Egyptian government from his reign until King Farouk's reign in the first half of the last century.

After stopping for lunch at a fine dining establishment, you will begin your well-known and highly anticipated tour of Coptic Cairo at the historic Roman fortress of Babylon. Here, you will be astounded by The Hanging Church, one of the main attractions of ancient Cairo. You will also see the church of St. Sergius, also called the Cavern Church, which was constructed above the crypt where the holy family spent almost three months and the well where they drank water. Lastly, you will go to the Ben Ezra Synagogue. Tradition has it that this is where the pharaoh's palace was, when Moses's basket was taken out of the Nile.

Follow our Cairo Sightseeing tours to learn about Islamic journeys across the city and discover the numerous artifacts from medieval Cairo, including the historic walls and mosques. The city's medieval madrasa, sails, and gates, as well as its ancient stone-paved alleyways that date back to the tenth century, are all worth seeing. The walk concludes with tea at Fishawy, the oldest cafe in Khan El Khalili, the old market.

Day 4: East Bank of Luxor Tour / Cairo to Luxor

You're going to move to Luxor on this day! After checking out of your Giza hotel in the morning, you will be driven to Cairo Airport to board a domestic flight that will take you to Luxor, the epicenter of Egypt's tourism, where our representative will meet and help you. We will drive you for around thirty minutes after you arrive in Luxor to board the Egypt Nile River Cruise, which will allow you to experience the enchantment of the river's endless flow and discover its fascinating monuments and history.

Check in and take a break in your cabin, then enjoy your lunch meal served on board the Nile cruise, then we start exploring the city of Luxor to see its highlights.

First, we will enjoy the East Bank of Luxor tour beginning with the complex of Karnak temples built

over 2 millennia to be a natural museum of ancient Egyptian art, a blueprint of the power and glory of a golden era, and a mine of historical information. Then head to the temple of Luxor, which is another measure of the greatness of the New Kingdom Pharaohs. Then you will be brought back to the ship to relax and have a leisurely evening before your lovely dinner meal is served in the boat's restaurant. Day 5: Edfu/West Bank of Luxor

After enjoying your delicious breakfast in the classy dining area of the Nile Cruise, our Luxor day trips get underway. Today, we will disembark from the boat and visit two of Egypt's most well-known sites: the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut, also known as El-Dier El Bahari, via the mini train, and the rock-carved tombs of the New Kingdom pharaohs in the Valley of the Kings.

Following this amazing experience on the west bank of the Luxor tour, you will be returned to the cruise ship and served lunch while the ship makes its way to Esna to pass the Lock. During tea time on the upper deck of the cruiser, take in the breathtaking view of the stunning Nile Valley. When you arrive at Edfu, you will be served a delectable oriental supper on board. There, you will spend the evening taking in the belly dance and musical performance while floating on the calm waters of the Nile.

Day 6: Touring Kom Ombo and Edfu Temple

After breakfast is served on the Nile Cruise, all passengers will return to the ship and begin sailing down the Nile to Kom Ombo. The boat will stop at Edfu so that you can take a horse-drawn carriage tour of the city's famous temple, which is devoted to the worship of the falcon god Horus. When we arrive, we will disembark for an incredible tour of the Kom Ombo temple, which was constructed to honor two gods: the crocodile god Sobek and Haroeris, a version of Horus that is worshipped at Kom Ombo.

When you finish your tea, head back to the Nile Cruise, which will now be traveling in the direction of Aswan. After dinner in the evening, you can relax on the Nile River while taking in the entertainment and another cozy night's sleep.

Day 7: Tour of Aswan's sights

As you prepare to begin your Aswan day trips, savor your breakfast in the morning on board the Nile Cruise. After being brought to see the magnificent High Dam of Aswan, you will be shown the largest unfinished obelisk in Egypt, which is located in the granite quarries of Aswan. After spending some time viewing the historical sights, return to the Nile Cruise. A delicious lunch will be provided as you take in the amazing views of the Nile River, the islands that have been preserved in their original state, and the various visiting birds that are soaring above the city. And while having tea in the roomy, open space, let your eyes feast on the splendor of these vistas.
