Day 1: Cairo Arrival

A representative from Cairo Top Tours will greet you at the airport upon your arrival and assist you with all the formalities. After that, you will ride in a private, air-conditioned car to your hotel for the night after checking in.

Day 2: Tour of the Egyptian Museum and the Giza Pyramids

After having breakfast at the hotel, start your day trip in Cairo by going to the Egyptian Museum:

Cairo is home to the Museum of Egyptian Antiquities, which our Egypt Classic Tours will see. The largest and most significant collection of ancient Egyptian art from all times may be seen there, showcasing 5000 years of splendor and artistic talent. With over 160,000 authentic artifacts on display—you could spend a month seeing each one for just a minute—the most highly valued displays may be discovered inside the tomb of the young Pharaoh Tutankhamun in Luxor's Valley of the Kings. Thousands of golden accessories and items since it was kept inside his tomb for almost 3,500 years before being completely discovered in the 1920s of the previous century.

After that, we'll take you on an incredible tour of the Giza Pyramids.

Our accredited tour guide will take you to see the Great Pyramid of King Cheops, the second pyramid constructed in Giza for King Chephren, and the final pyramid built by Pharaoh Mycerinus—the only two of the seven man-made wonders of the ancient world that still stand today.

Additionally, you will see the Great Sphinx of Giza.

The mythological Man-headed Lion is said to have been fashioned for King Chephren, and the Valley Temple is primarily focused on the Pharaoh's mummification procedures.

Before beginning your Islamic Cairo tours, have lunch locally in Khan El Khalili Bazaar. It is the oldest market still standing in Cairo. Take your time strolling about the neighborhood to take in the stunning mosques of Islamic Cairo and the historic structures. You can also shop for fine products here and have a delightful shopping tour of Cairo that will bring back wonderful memories of your excursions around the country.

Next, return to your hotel by transfer.

Day 3: Aswan excursions, Kom Ombo Temple, and Cairo to Aswan

Following the checkout process, you will be driven to the airport in Cairo International for your journey to Aswan. From there, our staff will meet you and take you to the Nile Cruise, where you will spend the next seven days exploring Cairo. Take off on your Egypt Nile River Cruise before the boat serves lunch. Begin your Aswan day trip by seeing the High Dam of Aswan, the temple of Philae, which the early Christians used as a church, and then sail to Kom Ombo. After that, you'll go to the impressive Kom Ombo Temple, which was once the center of worship for two Egyptian deities.

The earliest form of Horus the falcon, Haroeris, and the crocodile god, Sobek, the god of fertility. Set out on your voyage by boat to Edfu. Savor a delicious dinner that is served on board, and spend a fun-filled evening on your Nile cruise ship.

Day 4: Cruise to Luxor and Edfu Temple

After enjoying your early-morning meal on board the cruise ship, you will be taken to Edfu to see The Temple of Horus, one of the most significant temples in the history of ancient Egypt. After visiting Edfu Temple, you will cruise to Luxor by crossing the lock. After enjoying your afternoon tea, dinner will be served on the Nile River Cruise. In the evening, you can attend the Galabeya party.

Spend the night in Luxor.

Day 5: Tours of the Luxor West Bank

Enjoy a delicious breakfast on the Nile Cruise boat to start your day. Next, your representative will drive you across the Nile River to the west bank so you can visit the Valley of the Kings, where you can explore the interiors of the tombs of numerous rulers and see how ornate they are. Finally, you will go to the Temple of Deir El Bahari. The Colossi of Memnon, two enormous sitting statues of Amenhotep III facing the Nile, will be your next stop.

Following the tour of the west bank of Luxor, you will dine on board the cruise for lunch.

Day 6: Tour of Luxor's East Bank and Return to Cairo

Experience our incredible Luxor day tours after disembarking from the Nile Cruise. You will visit the largest place of worship in human history, Karnak Temple, as well as the sun god Amun and his triad, Luxor Temple, during our Egypt Classic Tours. At the Temple of Luxor, you will be astounded by the courtyard, massive columns, and the granite statues of Ramses II.

You will now enter the complex of Karnak Temples, which were constructed at different points in the history of ancient Egypt. The Avenue of Sphinxes comes first, followed by the incomplete pylon, the Hypostyle Hall with its 134 enormous columns, the tallest standing obelisks of Queen Hatshepsut and Tuthmosis III, the statue of the god Amun decorated with papyrus and lotus forms, the Sacred Lake, and the Granite Scarab beetle of Amenophis III, which was revered and called kb.

After that, you'll be driven to the airport in Luxor in time for your return trip to Cairo.

A representative from Cairo Top Tours will greet you at the airport and arrange for a transfer to your accommodation.

Spend the night in a hotel in Cairo.

Day 7: Last Day of Travel
