Itinerary

Day1: Cairo Arrival

Our tour guide will be waiting for you at Cairo International Airport, holding a sign with your name on it. After a long trip, you may now finally relax! After that, a private air-conditioned car will transport you to your accommodation. Our consultant will assist you with a seamless check-in process and go over your vacation schedule with you when you arrive at the hotel. By doing this, you can make sure that you agree on the times for each tour's pickup. You'll also get a welcome drink handed to you.

Stay the night in Cairo.

Day 2: Tour to Saqqara and the Pyramids

Your private tour guide will meet you at the Cairo hotel after breakfast to start your Cairo day trip.

You will go to the well-known Giza Plateau to witness the Great Pyramid of Cheops, the lone surviving structure of the seven ancient man-made wonders. You will also see the pyramids of Mycerinus and Chephren, the ancestors of Snefru and Cheops. The fourth reigning family of the old kingdom of ancient Egypt was founded by Snefru. In addition, the Great Sphinx and the Valley Temple, a mummification temple, which confronts the massive statue, are visible.

You will get the chance to shoot a panoramic picture and have the ideal group shot during the tour of the Giza pyramids. An additional possible activity at the Giza Pyramids is to take a camel ride.

Come with me to the Saqqara Necropolis, home of the magnificent Teti Pyramid from the sixth dynasty, which has an amazing interior, and the Djoser's step pyramid, the world's first structure made entirely of stone. We'll also tour the Tombs of the Nobles in Saqqara, which were constructed for the husbands of King Teti's daughters. By examining the intricate murals and inscriptions on the walls and passageways of these 4,000-year-old tombs, we can discover more about daily life in ancient Egypt.

Get ready for our trip to Memphis, the capital of the pharaohs for a millennium and an important center of religion and culture for the entire three millennia of ancient Egyptian civilization, after lunch. We're heading to the outdoor museum, which is well-known for its enormous, broken statue of Ramses the Second and its alabaster sphinx, the second-largest of its kind carved from an 80-ton piece of marble.

We're going to spend the night in Cairo at your hotel.

Day 3: Traveling by air to Aswan

Head to Cairo International Airport first thing in the morning after checking out of the hotel. Take a flight to Aswan, where you will be met by our personnel in the area and taken to the cruise. After having lunch on board, start your Aswan day trips to see the Philae temple and the High Dam. Visit the temples of Sobek and Haroeris, sail to Kom Ombo, and enjoy afternoon tea. Continue your journey to Edfu to view the magnificent temples. You can attend the disco party to round off the day after dinner on the boat.

Lunch, dinner, and breakfast are served.

Day 4: Temples of Edfu

On your Nile Cruise, we will visit Edfu's Temple of Horus after breakfast. The most striking structure devoted to the worship of Horus, the falcon-shaped god of the sky and ancient Egypt's guardian of royalty, is this temple. We will sail to Luxor after the visit and cross the lock. Savor your meal and afternoon tea aboard before heading to the Galabya celebration.

Breakfast, lunch, and supper meals

Day 5: Sightseeing Cruises on the Luxor Nile

Start your day with breakfast aboard the boat, and then take a tour of the west bank of Luxor. You can explore the Valley of the Kings and visit the tombs of many dynasties from the new kingdom here. Visit the Temple of Deir El Bahari after that before proceeding with the tour of the East Bank of Luxor. See the magnificent Karnak complex here, constructed by numerous monarchs as the seat of Amun-Re, the solar disk deity of ancient Egyptian religion. You will also see the magnificent Luxor Temple, whose courtyard, columns, and granite statues of Ramses the Great will astound you. The trip will come to an end at the Colossi of Memnon on the way back, two enormous statues facing the Nile, each one depicting Amenhotep III. After that, savor lunch on the Nile Cruise and spend the evening thinking back on your fantastic day trips of Luxor.

Day 7: Optional Excursions in Sharm El Shiekh

You have the option of joining our extra tour to Ras Mohammed National Park or enjoying a free day in Sharm El Sheikh. This 480 square kilometer park is a protected region with both aquatic and terrestrial natural reserves. It is situated where the Gulf of Suez and the Gulf of Aqaba converge in the southernmost point of Sinai. Thousands of white storks pass through Ras Mohammed annually, migrating south in September and October and north again in April and May. There are about 85 different kinds of flora in the park, including mangroves.

Day 8: Optional Excursions in Sharm El Shiekh

After 2:00 pm, you have the option of joining an optional excursion that includes transportation from your hotel to the Quad Bike Center and a 15-minute drive. Alternatively, you can spend a leisurely morning without any plans. Before starting your Quad Bike journey, you will be given some quick safety and driving lessons as you arrive.

Take a journey across the Sinai desert and take in the amazing vistas. Take a pause and sample some real Bedouin herbal tea at the summit of Wadi Al-Aat, which takes around an hour to reach. You will be taken back to your lodging after your bike ride back to Sharm.

Day 9: Optional Excursions in Sharm El Shiekh

You have the choice of visiting the monastery of Saint Catherine, which is located in the center of Sinai at the base of Gebel Musa (Mount Sinai), where Moses is supposed to have received the commandments, or you can spend a day at leisure in Sharm. The Greek Orthodox Church runs the monastery, which is encircled by gardens and cypress trees.

Rich and expansive, the library houses the world's second-largest collection of illuminated manuscripts, after the Vatican. A wide range of historic artworks, including as precious icons, finely carved doors, breathtaking wall paintings, and other religious decorations, are available for viewing by guests. One noteworthy item is the Burning Bush.

Day 11: Tours of Cairo's Sightseeing

Start your vacation to Cairo with an early breakfast at your hotel. After that, your personal tour guide will take you to the Egyptian Museum, which is home to the greatest collection of Egyptian antiquities in the world as well as the only royal treasure that is completely intact: the Treasures of the Golden Pharaoh Tutankhamen. All of our Egypt Classic Tours plans include this.

Moving on, we will visit the Mohamed Ali Alabaster Mosque at the Citadel of Saladin. From there, we can take in a broad view of Cairo's Islamic quarter, which is home to numerous mosques, minarets, and domes that date back hundreds or even thousands of years.

Take the tour of the ancient Roman fortification of Babylon with the Coptic people. See the church of St. Sergius, which held the holy family for over three months, and admire the Hanging Church, which is hanging above the historic towers. See the spring that supplied their water supply as well. Lastly, proceed to the Ben Ezra Synagogue, which is thought to be the site of the pharaoh's palace from which Moses was discovered floating on the Nile River in a basket.

We will explore Cairo's Islamic neighborhood after lunch and take in its historic streets, walls, and barricades that date back to the tenth century. Our stroll will come to an end with a delicious tea at Fishawy, Khan El Khalili's oldest cafe, Cairo's old bazaar. At the end of the day, we will return to the hotel and spend the night in Cairo.
