Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival to Cairo

Upon arrival in Egypt, the Cairo Top Tours tour leader will meet you at <u>Cairo International Airport</u>, and he will hold a signboard with your name on it. You will be driven to your hotel by your tour guide and a private driver in a comfortable, air-conditioned vehicle. Our representative will assist you with a simple check-in at the hotel, go over your <u>Egypt Easter Tours</u> itinerary with you to confirm pick-up times for each tour day, and serve you a welcome drink.

Day 2: Tour to the Giza Pyramids and the Egyptian Museum

You will meet your professional tour guide to begin your Egypt Easter tour after eating breakfast. You will be transferred to the Giza Plateau to visit the Great Pyramid of Cheops, which is one of the seven wonders of the world, and was constructed out of more than 2.6 million rock pieces, each weighing 50 tons. One of ancient Egypt's most well-known kings was King Cheops. He succeeded Cheops as the second king in the fourth family and was Sneferu's son. Sneferu had been the king before Cheops. No other king has achieved his level of notoriety.

You will then see the middle pyramid as being larger than the Great Pyramid and smaller than the pyramid of Mycerinus, which is the smallest of the three main pyramids of the Giza Pyramid Complex. King Chephren wanted to build a pyramid bigger than his father's pyramid of Cheops, but because he honoured his father, he decided to build a smaller one.

You will also see The Great Sphinx of Giza, which is a limestone statue of a sphinx in a reclining position. Sphinxes are mythical creatures with human-like heads and lion-like bodies. It is located on the Giza Plateau, on the western bank of the Nile, in Giza, Egypt, and faces directly from west to east. It was constructed by King Chephren to guard the pyramids from cemetery thieves so that they would believe a real God was defending them.

<u>The Valley Temple</u>, which served as King Chephren's mortuary temple, is where we'll go next. Then, before going to the centre of Cairo to have lunch at an elite area restaurant.

The world's largest museum, the Egyptian Museum, will be your next stop. It is home to more than 120,000 artifacts and enormous statues, such as the Golden King Tutankhamun and his priceless treasures.

The Hanging Church, the most well-known location in Coptic Cairo, will then be visited by you as part of the tour of the old Coptic Cairo. The Church of the Virgin Mary is also known by its nickname, the Hanging Church. This name derives from the fact that it was constructed on top of a southern wall of a Roman fortress in Babylon that dates back to the fourth century BC.

You will also go to the St. him Church, which served as the holy family's safe haven while they hid from Herod the Great and the Roman soldiers. The Ben Ezra Synagogue is also thought to be the location where Baby Moses' box was found. It is regarded as a place of prayer for Jews.

Continue your tour with your tour guide to visit the Islamic Cairo area, where you will spend time in the Khan El Khalili Market, which is the most famous ancient market and bazaar in Egypt. Here, visitors can find beautiful Egyptian souvenirs. El Fishawy Cafe is one of the most popular coffee shops in the El-Hussein Area, and it is a great place to sip tea. Finally, we will transfer you back to your hotel.

Meals: Breakfast, lunch, and dinner

Day 3: Arrival to Luxor / Luxor excursions

After breakfast, you will check out from the hotel. You will then be driven to Cairo International Airport for your flight to Luxor, where a Cairo Top Tours representative will meet and assist you.

Your guide will transfer you from Luxor Airport to your 5-star Nile Cruise. Start your East Bank tour by visiting the magnificent Temple of Luxor, which is stunningly illuminated at night, after eating lunch on board. You will visit the Karnak Temple, which is the largest temple ever built by a human being. You will have your lunch abroad on the cruise. You will spend the night on your cruise.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Day 4: The West Bank of Luxor tour

You will enjoy your breakfast on the cruise.

You will cross the Nile to see the two enormous statues of Amenhotep III, which are known as the Colossi of Memnon, after that you will go to the Valley of the Kings, which contains the tombs of 62 New Kingdom pharaohs, such as the fabled Ramesses II and the famous Tutankhamun. Continue your tour by visiting El Deir El Bahary, also known as Hatshepsut's Temple, who is the first female ruler in recorded history. The Pharaohs' palace was bursting with paintings and filled with treasures they intended to enjoy in the afterlife. Following lunch, you will cruise the Nile to Edfu while enjoying dinner, and spend the night there.

Meals: Breakfast, lunch, and dinner

Day 5: Tour to Edfu and Kom Ombo Temples

You will eat breakfast on the Nile Cruise, and our representative will then go with you to visit Edfu Temple, which is a well-preserved temple from the Ptolemaic era that is dedicated to the falcon-headed god Horus. Then you will set sail for Kom Ombo to see the fascinating Temple of Kom Ombo, which is constructed according to a traditional layout with an entrance pylon, forecourt, hypostyle hall, and surrounding chambers leading to the sanctuary. An invisible division runs down the middle of the temple and separates two hallways, related forecourts, and colonnaded halls, leading to related sanctuaries, one of which is dedicated to Horus and the other to Sobek. Lunch will then be served on board before sailing to Aswan.

Then, spend the night on the Nile cruise after a delicious dinner.

Meals: Breakfast, lunch, and dinner

Day 6 : Aswan tours

Enjoy your breakfast then your Egyptologist tour guide will accompany you to the famous <u>High Dam</u>, which was built between 1960 and 1971 by Nasser, who was Egypt's second president. The High Dam increased the country's ability to produce power and allowed for the management of floods. Water could also be stored for release over a number of years.

Then, you'll explore the magnificent <u>Philae Temple</u>, which is one of Egypt's oldest temples and home to the goddess Isis. It is an island-based temple complex that was formerly situated on Philae Island, which was submerged by floodwaters after the construction of the high dam. The temple was then moved by the government to Agilika Island, another island.

You will go to the <u>Unfinished Obelisk</u> after that. The largest obelisk was built by the ancient Egyptians during the reign of Queen Hatshepsut, and it is still visible today in the granite quarries close to the city of Aswan, exactly where it was once partially carved out of solid rock.

Dinner will then be served before you return to the ship.

Meals: Breakfast, lunch, and dinner

Day 7: Back to Cairo

You will leave your Nile cruise after breakfast is served. For your return flight to Cairo, our representative will transfer you to the Aswan Airport.

When you arrive at Cairo International Airport, our representative will be waiting for you. He will help you with all the necessary procedures, and then he will drive you to your hotel. You'll spend the night at the Cairo hotel.

Day 8: The End of Your Easter Travel Package in Egypt
