Day 1: Arrive Cairo, Check-In

Welcome to the enchanting Land of the Pharaohs! A representative from Cairo Top Tours will be eagerly awaiting your arrival at Cairo International Airport. You'll be swiftly transported to your hotel in a private vehicle, where you'll receive assistance with the check-in process and have your itinerary reviewed to ensure that your Easter Tours in Egypt are nothing short of perfect. To kick off your journey, a refreshing welcome drink will be offered upon your arrival at the hotel.

Day 3: Fly to Aswan, Aswan Excursions

After having your buffet breakfast, you will be transferred by our representative to Cairo international airport to catch your flight traveling to Aswan. Upon arrival, our certified Egyptologist will meet you to begin your excursions in Aswan by visiting the exceptional Aswan High Dam which protected Egypt from the problem of being flooded by the Nile water every year, then you will visit the Unfinished Obelisk at the granite quarries, the obelisk was created from a separate piece of stone during the time of Queen Hatshepsut but never finished or used in any temple. Then you will continue Aswan excursions to visit the Temple of Philae, dedicated to the worship of Goddess Isis. The temple will capture your eyes with its beauty.

She was called Gamot Amon or Hatshepsut any of Amon's favorite girlfriends over ladies, or Amon's girlfriend Dora Princesses. The most prominent queens who ruled Egypt, and their powerful influence; Her rule was a landmark not only in the history of the eighteenth family but also in the entire ancient history of Egypt.

You will then be transferred to your hotel in Aswan for check-in and overnight after having your delicious lunch in one of the best restaurants in Aswan.

Day 4: Luxor Tours

After enjoying a delectable breakfast at your hotel, you will be chauffeured to Luxor in a private vehicle, accompanied by your licensed tour guide, for an unforgettable exploration of Luxor's east and west banks.

Our journey commences with the east bank of Luxor, where we will delve into the magnificent Karnak Temple complex. This awe-inspiring temple, a testament to the devotion of multiple kings from different dynasties, served as the epicenter of religion during the golden age of ancient Egypt. At that time, Egypt was a formidable kingdom, extending its influence as far as Mesopotamia and Libya.

Our Luxor excursions then lead us to the royal tombs nestled in the Valley of the Kings. This sacred burial ground was the final resting place for many of Egypt's rulers during the New Kingdom. You will have the privilege of exploring three tombs, and it gained worldwide fame following the discovery of King Tutankhamun's tomb, brimming with intact golden treasures, in 1902.

We also visit the Mortuary Temple of Queen Hatshepsut, a testament to her reign and built under the supervision of her devoted architect, Senmout. This temple is dedicated to Queen Hatshepsut herself and honors the trinity of Amun. Inside, the divine birth story of her majesty is vividly depicted. Our Luxor sightseeing tour continues as we encounter the colossal statues of King Amenhotep III, who initiated the construction of the Temple of Luxor.

Following a satisfying lunch, we transfer you to your hotel in Luxor for check-in, where you will spend the night.

Day 5: Fly to Cairo, Islamic and Coptic Cairo Tours

Start your day with a delightful breakfast in the enchanting city of Luxor, often regarded as the most beautiful city in Egypt. You will be greeted by our representative, who will assist you in making your way to [Luxor airport](#) for your return flight to Cairo. Upon arrival in Cairo, your dedicated tour guide will be there to kick off an unforgettable journey through [Coptic and Islamic Cairo tour](#).

Our exploration begins with the Coptic Cairo tour, in the renowned area of Old Cairo. Here, you will encounter the ancient [Roman fortress of Babylon](#), constructed during the 1st century. Atop its towers stands [the Hanging Church](#) of the Holy Virgin Mary, dating back to the Patriarchate of Isaac of Alexandria in the 7th century. This church is adorned with around 110 original and replica icons. Our tour continues with a visit to the Church of St. Sergius and Bacchus, a structure dating to the 5th century, which houses the crypt where the Holy Family resided for three months. We will also explore the Ben Ezra Synagogue, the oldest synagogue in Cairo, originally sold by Christians to a wealthy Jewish man to meet onerous tax obligations.

Savor a delectable lunch at one of the local Egyptian restaurants before embarking on your Islamic Cairo adventure. We will visit the Citadel of Saladin in Cairo, a medieval fortress erected by the famous Muslim leader Saladin during the 12th century. Inside the citadel, we will explore the Alabaster Mosque of Mohamed Ali, a mosque that boasts Turkish-style architecture reminiscent of the Blue Mosque in Istanbul. It was constructed by Mohamed Ali Basha in 1805, and he is now laid to rest within the mosque.

Following these enriching experiences, we will transfer you back to your hotel in Cairo for check-in, where you can relax and rest after a day of captivating Egypt day tours.
