Day 8: Sharm El Shiekh Optional Excursions

You have the option to enjoy a leisurely day in Sharm El-Sheikh at your own pace or book our optional tour to Ras Mohammed National Park, which is one of the most beautiful Parks in Egypt. This unique park serves as both a terrestrial and aquatic nature reserve, covering an expansive 480 square kilometers at the meeting point of the Gulf of Suez and the Gulf of Aqaba in the southern region of Sinai. The protected area boasts an arid desert landscape featuring sand dunes, gravel plains, fossilized corals, and granite mountains. Within this rugged terrain, you may have the opportunity to see rare mammal species such as Dorcas gazelle, Nubian ibex, and red fox. The park is also a habitat for various resident bird species, including terns, herons, gulls, and ospreys. Ras Mohammed plays a crucial role for thousands of white storks that migrate through the area, heading south during September-October and returning north during April-May. Additionally, the park is home to approximately 85 plant species, including mangroves.

Your night will be spent at your Sharm El-Sheikh hotel.
