Day 1: Arrival in Cairo

Upon your arrival at <u>Cairo International Airport</u>, our representative will be ready and waiting for you. You will be escorted to your hotel in Cairo in a private car.

Upon reaching the hotel, our representative will go over the details of your 6 Days Cairo and Nile Cruise Easter Tours itinerary with you. This is the perfect time to confirm pick-up times and discuss any additional sightseeing or excursions you may want to add during your stay in Egypt.

Enjoy a comfortable overnight stay in Cairo, complete with a welcome drink to kick off your Egyptian adventure!

Day 02: The Great Pyramid, Egyptian Museum, Coptic Cairo

Start your day with a delightful breakfast before embarking on one of our captivating <u>Cairo day tours</u> to explore the iconic Giza Pyramids.

Marvel at the Great Pyramid of Cheops and the Pyramid of Chephren, along with the smallest royal pyramid in Giza, constructed for the burial of King Mycerinus, a notable ruler of the <u>fourth dynasty</u>. Learn about the historical significance of the Sphinx with the guidance of a specialist Egyptologist, and explore the Valley Temple, also known as the mummification temple of King Chephren. This remarkable structure, made from Aswan granite quarries and adorned with white alabaster, will leave you in awe.

Accompanied by your knowledgeable tour guide and personal driver, delve into the treasures of <u>Tutankhamun</u> at the Egyptian Museum. A break for lunch at a local restaurant will recharge you for the next part of your adventure.

Continue your exploration with a tour of Coptic Cairo, where you'll discover ancient churches and synagogues. Begin with the <u>Hanging Church</u>, perched above the remnants of an ancient Roman fortress. Move on to the Cavern Church of Abu Serga, a sanctuary where the holy family sought refuge during their journey to Egypt. Conclude your visit with the oldest Jewish temple in Egypt, the <u>Ben Ezra Synagogue</u>.

Return to the hotel for a well-deserved overnight stay, reflecting on the day's discoveries.

Day 03: Cairo to Aswan By Air

After checking out, our representative will transfer you to Cairo International Airport, approximately an hour's drive from Giza. From there, you'll catch a 1-hour flight to Aswan. Upon arrival in Aswan, you'll be met and transferred to embark on your 5-star Nile Cruise, considered one of the best Egypt Nile River Cruises.

In the afternoon, your accredited tour guide and driver will take you for a delightful sail on the <u>River Nile by Felucca</u> around <u>Kitchener's Island</u> and Agha Khan Mausoleum, followed by afternoon tea. Indulge in an open-buffet dinner served aboard the boat, accompanied by a captivating Nubian Folkloric show.

As an option, you can attend the sound and light show at Philae Temple in the evening, delving into the myth of Osiris and Isis in a truly enchanting atmosphere.

Day 04: Aswan Tours, Kom Ombo Temple, Sail to Edfu

Continue your journey to Edfu, enjoying afternoon tea and a Captain's welcome cocktail while sailing. Indulge in a delectable dinner with entertainment provided by disco music in the lounge bar. Spend the night aboard the cruise in Edfu.

Day 05: Edfu Temple, Sail to Luxor

Begin your day with a delightful breakfast served aboard your boat before meeting your tour guide for a sightseeing tour to the Temple of Horus in Edfu. Marvel at the exquisite Ptolemaic architecture dedicated to Horus, with a commanding granite statue of Horus guarding the temple entrance, adorned with the Double Crown of Upper and Lower Egypt. After absorbing the rich history of Edfu, return to the Nile Cruise ship and set sail for Luxor.

Lunch will be served on board, followed by afternoon tea. In the evening, indulge in a high-quality dinner onboard the ship, and then immerse yourself in the joy of a traditional Galabya party.

Day 06: Luxor Excursions, back to Cairo, Final Departure
