<u>Itinerary</u>

Day 1 : Arrival to Cairo, Visit Giza Pyramids, Saqqara and Dahshur

Upon your arrival at <u>Cairo International Airport</u>, our representative will warmly greet you and transfer you to your hotel, allowing you to drop off your luggage before embarking on your day tour.

Commence your exploration by visiting the iconic <u>Giza Pyramids</u> and the Great <u>Sphinx</u>, situated in the Giza Necropolis. Our Egypt day tours offer insightful information about the Great Pyramid of Giza (Cheops Pyramid), the Pyramid of Khafre (Chephren), and the Pyramid of Menkaure (Mecerinus), along with their associated pyramid complexes. Learn about the mysteries of the Great Sphinx of Giza and the Valley Temple as you descend from the high plateau. For an extra adventure, opt for a camel ride at the Giza plateau to enjoy the stunning panoramic views (Optional Activity).

Next, a transfer to <u>Saqqara</u> Necropolis awaits, providing an opportunity to explore one of ancient Egypt's renowned sites. Delve into the <u>Step Pyramid</u> of Djoser and discover the tombs of important nobles, including the Tomb of Teti, who ruled during the 6th dynasty.

Continue your journey to the Dahshur archaeological site to explore the pyramids. These two pyramids, belonging to King Snefru, father of King Cheops, invite you to enter both the Red Pyramid and the <u>Bent Pyramid</u>. Dahshur's necropolis dates back to the beginning of the 4th dynasty of Egypt's history.

Snefru, the visionary leader of the Fourth Dynasty, left a lasting legacy with his achievements in foreign trade, mining campaigns, and engineering prowess, shaping the pyramid complex at Dahshur. Today, visitors can marvel at these impressive structures, a testament to Snefru's contributions.

Indulge in a delightful lunch at one of our local restaurants in Giza before being transferred back to your hotel by our knowledgeable tour leader.

Day 02: Alexandria Day Tour from Cairo

Embark on your enchanting tour of Alexandria from Cairo with your personal tour guide and car driver

awaiting you after breakfast.

Alexandria, established in 332 B.C. by the legendary leader Alexander the Great, once served as the capital of Egypt for nearly 1000 years until the Arab conquest in the 7th century. Even after this historic shift, Alexandria retained its status as the second most important city after Cairo.

Upon reaching Alexandria, your journey kicks off with a visit to the Catacombs of Kom El Shoqafa. Originally a private tomb for a wealthy Romanized Egyptian family, it later expanded to become a burial site for the common people of Alexandria. A short drive will then take you to the majestic Pompey's Pillar, the tallest standing pillar in Egypt. Erected by the people of Alexandria, it symbolizes gratitude to Roman Emperor Diocletian for diverting a portion of the annual tribute of corn and grain from Egypt to Rome for the relief of its citizens.

Take in the breathtaking views of the Mediterranean Sea en route to the Citadel of Qaitbay, established in 1477 A.D. on the legendary ruins of the Pharos Lighthouse.

Savor a delightful seafood lunch at a picturesque restaurant in Alexandria before heading to the modern Bibliotheca of Alexandria. Rebuilt after a previous fire, this library stands as a testament to the city's rich cultural heritage.

Your private driver and guide will then accompany you back to Cairo, with a midway stop for some rest and refreshments.

Enjoy an overnight stay at the hotel in Cairo.

Day 03: Egyptian Museum, Coptic and Islamic Cairo Tour

Embark on an exciting day after enjoying a delicious breakfast, as our Egyptologist guides you through the wonders of the Egyptian Museum. Delve into the smallest details of the world's most extensive collection of Egyptian antiquities, featuring treasures like the golden mask and coffins of King Tutankhamen.

Following your exploration of the museum, our journey through Islamic Cairo commences with a visit to the Citadel of Saladin, housing the magnificent Mohamed Ali Alabaster Mosque. Built in the 12th century by Mamluk rulers as a defense against crusaders, the mosque was later added by the Ottoman King Mohammed Ali in 1830.

Indulge in a delightful lunch break before embarking on the Coptic Cairo tour, a highlight of our Egypt Easter Tours. Venture into the Coptic district, where you'll encounter the remains of an ancient Roman fortress, Babylon, built in the 1st century. Above it stands the Hanging Church, suspended on the towers, followed by a stroll through narrow alleys reminiscent of old streets in Jerusalem. Visit the Church of St. Sergius, associated with the Holy Family's presence during their escape to Egypt. Conclude the Coptic Cairo tour with a visit to the ancient Jewish area, witnessing the Ben Ezra Synagogue, originally a Christian church before being sold to a Jewish man.

As we continue exploring Islamic Cairo, take a leisurely walk along <u>El Moez Ledin Ellah Street</u>, the oldest in Fatimid Cairo, showcasing Islamic art and architecture. Reach the old market, Al Azhar Mosque, and enjoy a break at El Fishawy, the oldest cafe in Khan El Khalili, with Turkish coffee or a refreshing mango juice.

Return to the hotel by car and spend the night in Cairo.

Day 04 : Cairo to Luxor

Meet our tour guide in the hotel lobby for your flight to Luxor from Cairo airport, marking the continuation of your Egypt tours. Upon your arrival in Luxor, we'll be eagerly awaiting you at the airport, facilitating your check-in at the hotel. Whether you choose to rest or dive straight into the tour, we're ready to make your experience exceptional.

Embark on the West Bank of Luxor tour, beginning with the renowned Valley of the Kings, the necropolis of the new kingdom pharaohs known worldwide. Explore three remarkable tombs within the Valley of the Kings. Next, visit the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut, also known as the Temple of Deir El Bahari, meaning the Northern Monastery. Conclude the West Bank tour with a visit to the Colossi of Memnon, the only remains from King Amenophis III's mortuary temple, facing the Nile.

Savor a gourmet lunch at a delightful local restaurant in Luxor before continuing with the East Bank of Luxor tour. Explore the magnificent Complex of Karnak Temple, a marvel built over 2000 years by various ancient Egyptian kings and rulers. Stroll through the Avenue of the sphinxes, connecting the Karnak and Luxor temples. Admire the Unfinished Pylon of King Nectanebo and the Hypostyle hall with its 134 gigantic columns. Learn about the largest standing Obelisk in Egypt, crafted by Queen Hatshepsut, and explore the temple of Amon adorned with lotus and papyrus designs. Discover the Granite Scarab of Amenophis III and the sacred lake within the temple.

Spend the night in Luxor, where you can also enjoy optional excursions, such as the Sound and Light Show in <u>Karnak Temple</u>.

Day 05: Luxor to Aswan

Your day kicks off early with a 7:00 am flight from Luxor to Aswan after completing the check-out process. The journey from Aswan to Luxor by land takes approximately 3 hours.

Upon arrival, your Aswan sightseeing adventure begins with a visit to the Aswan High Dam, located 6.5 km south of the Aswan Dam, a crucial component of Egypt's economic development envisioned by President Gamal Abdel Nasser.

Next, you'll be guided to a boat to explore the Philae Temple. This historic site spans four significant periods: the late Pharaonic era, the Ptolemaic era, the Roman epoch, and the Christian period in Egypt. Key monuments include the Temple of Isis and Horus, the Temple of Hathor, and the Kiosk.

Conclude your Aswan day tour and indulge in a delectable lunch in Aswan. Afterward, you'll be taken to the hotel in Aswan for check-in.

Overnight in Aswan.

Day 06: Abu Simbel to Cairo

Explore the magnificent Abu Simbel temples, renowned for the grand temples of Ramses II. Immerse yourself in the fascinating history of these temples as our Egyptologist guides you through their secrets. Following your enlightening visit, enjoy a delightful meal.

For your records, the Abu Simbel temples constitute an immense rock-cut temple complex featuring two colossal temples carved into the mountainside. Constructed during the reign of Ramses II, these temples were dedicated to the pharaoh himself and his beloved wife, Queen <u>Nefertari</u>. Return to Aswan around 13:00 pm, then transfer to <u>Aswan airport</u> for your flight back to Cairo.

Upon arrival at Cairo airport, our Cairo Top Tours representative will greet you and transfer you to the hotel in Cairo for check-in, where you'll spend the night.
