<u>Itinerary</u>

Day 1: Arrival in Cairo

Upon your arrival at <u>Cairo International Airport</u>, our dedicated Cairo Top Tours representative will be there to greet you. He will hold a signboard with your name, as they will escort you to the hotel in Giza or Cairo for a smooth check-in and an overnight stay.

Take the day to relax or book one of our enticing Easter day tours, such as the mesmerizing Sound and Light Show at the Giza Pyramids. Alternatively, indulge in a delightful 2-hour <u>Nile dinner cruise in Cairo</u>, featuring an oriental show and an open buffet of authentic Egyptian cuisine.

Enjoy a refreshing welcome drink upon arrival.

Day 2: Giza Pyramids, Coptic and Islamic Cairo Tours

Indulge in a delightful breakfast at the hotel before meeting your Egyptologist guide for an immersive day of Cairo tours. Start your tour by visiting the awe-inspiring Giza Pyramids, the oldest monuments in the world and a sacred site in ancient Egyptian history. Explore the Great Pyramid of King Cheops (Khufu), where your guide will unravel the mysteries of ancient Egyptian religion and its profound influence on the construction of monumental structures that were dedicated to the gods.

You can book an optional camel riding tour in the Giza Pyramids for a unique experience, immersing yourself in the beauty of the Sahara.

Enter the <u>Valley Temple</u> of Chephren, which is the complete pyramid complex of King Cheops' successor. Marvel at the Great Sphinx, which is a mythical figure symbolizing the king's authority and wisdom.

Embark on the <u>Coptic and Islamic Cairo tours</u> by visiting the <u>Citadel of Saladin</u>, which is a medieval fortress that was built by Sultan Saladin in the 12th century. Explore the magnificent Alabaster Mosque of Mohamed Ali Basha, commissioned to rid Egypt of the French expedition led by Napoleon Bonaparte.

Next, delve into Coptic Cairo with visits to the <u>Hanging Church</u>, which was constructed on the remains of <u>the Roman Fortress of Babylon</u>, and the <u>Synagogue of Ben Ezra</u>, which was one of Egypt's oldest Jewish temples. Explore the <u>Church of St. Sergius</u>, which is also known as the cavern church, housing the crypt where baby Jesus and Mary sought refuge during their escape from King Herod.

You will be transferred back to your hotel for a relaxing overnight stay.

Meals: Breakfast, and Lunch

Day 3: Check-Out (Optional Tour to Saqqara and Memphis)

Savor your daily buffet breakfast and proceed to check out of the hotel for your transfer to Cairo International Airport or your designated drop-off location. If you have time you can book an optional tour of the Saqqara Necropolis. Explore the Step Pyramid of Djoser, the tombs of nobles, and the ancient city of Memphis, which is home to numerous statues of King Ramses II from the New Kingdom and the remarkable alabaster sphinx of Memphis.

The Step Pyramid, which was constructed between 2737 BC and 2717 BC, lies to the south of Giza in Egypt and serves as the resting place of King Djoser. The pyramid's construction spanned 20 years, and a notable discovery in 1924 revealed a well-preserved statue of Djoser, despite attempts at theft during modern times. This statue is currently housed in the Egyptian Museum.
