Day 1: Egypt Arrive Cairo,

Upon your arrival at Cairo International Airport, our dedicated representative will be ready to greet you and provide a seamless transition to your Cairo hotel.

As you check in at the hotel, you will be treated to a refreshing welcome drink. Our representative will take this opportunity to go over the specifics of your 5-Day Cairo and Luxor Easter Tour Package itinerary, ensuring that your Egypt Easter Tours are proceeding as planned and assisting you with a hassle-free check-in process.

Day 2: Giza Pyramids, Saqqara Necropolis, Memphis City

Begin your day on your Egypt Easter travel with a delightful buffet breakfast at your hotel. Following that, you'll meet your tour guide to embark on your first Cairo excursion. Your adventure kicks off with a visit to the remarkable Giza Pyramids, part of the Saqqara and Giza [Old kingdom](#) necropolis.

Marvel at the grandeur of the structures constructed during the [4th dynasty](#), created by renowned Egyptian kings [Cheops](#), [Chephren](#), and [Mycerinus](#). These three pyramids were meticulously aligned with specific stars and served as burial tombs for these semi-divine monarchs. The largest of these, built for King Cheops, will be thoroughly explained by your knowledgeable tour guide, shedding light on the incredible construction techniques and the historical significance.

For an optional and memorable experience, ascend to a high vantage point for a [camel](#) ride around the [Giza Pyramids](#). A Bedouin guide will assist you and capture stunning photographs of this unique adventure.

You'll also encounter the iconic Great Sphinx, a colossal 73-meter-tall statue with the head of a man and the body of a lion, and the nearby [Valley Temple](#), another integral part of King Chephren's funerary complex.

Next, your driver will transport you to the Saqqara Necropolis, located approximately 45 minutes away from Cairo. Here, you'll find the oldest stone pyramid in Egypt, the Step Pyramid, constructed by the renowned architect Imhotep for his ruler, King Djoser of the 3rd dynasty. This pyramid represents a fascinating transitional period in the evolution of royal burial tombs and is a remarkable historical site to explore.

You'll have the opportunity to visit the [Pyramid of Teti](#), who reigned during the sixth dynasty, and the tomb of his son-in-law, Kagemni. Kagemni's tomb stands out due to its well-preserved condition and the rich offering and hunting scenes depicted on its walls.

Savor a delectable Egyptian lunch at a local restaurant to refuel for the rest of your day.

Following this, you'll be transferred to Memphis, now known as Mit Rahina, to explore the open-air museum housing remarkable artifacts, including the alabaster sphinx of Memphis and the colossal statue of [Ramses II](#). This powerful New Kingdom pharaoh is also renowned for the majestic Abu Simbel Temples in Aswan.

As your day of exploration comes to an end, you'll be transported back to your hotel for a relaxing overnight stay.

Day 3: Fly to Luxor, East Bank Tours

After your transfer by our representative to Cairo airport, you will catch a flight to Luxor. Upon your arrival at Luxor airport, you will be warmly welcomed by your private tour guide who will be your companion for the next two days of exploration in Luxor.

Begin your [Luxor day tours](#) on the captivating Luxor east bank. Your first stop is the remarkable Luxor Temple, one of the most extraordinary temples in Luxor. Originally built by [King Amenhotep III](#) and later expanded and completed by various ancient Egyptian kings and rulers, this temple stands as a testament to the grandeur of this remarkable civilization and the profound significance of religion in ancient Egyptian life.

Stroll through the awe-inspiring avenue of the sphinxes that leads you into the Temple of Karnak, a monumental religious and administrative center during the New Kingdom period. This vast temple complex was developed and expanded by numerous pharaohs across different eras, ultimately becoming the largest religious structure in the world.

Following your enlightening tour, enjoy a delicious lunch at a local restaurant in Luxor. Afterward, you'll proceed to your hotel for check-in and a comfortable overnight stay.

Day 4: Luxor West Bank Tours, Fly Back to Cairo

After enjoying a hearty breakfast at your hotel, you'll rendezvous with your licensed Egyptologist to continue your Luxor sightseeing tours. Today's focus will be on exploring the [Luxor west bank](#), home to a wealth of historical monuments. Your journey commences with a visit to the New Kingdom necropolis, the [Valley of the Kings](#), a site where over 63 royal tombs have been discovered concealed amidst the hills. Among the most remarkable tombs unearthed here is the tomb of the renowned King Tutankhamen, whose treasures are now exhibited in the Egyptian Museum. Tutankhamen, a young king, ascended to the throne at the age of nine and was named after the ancient Egyptian god Amon. His reign marked a transitional period in ancient Egyptian history, following the unconventional rule of Pharaoh Akhenaton, who sought to unify the gods of Egypt.

Following your exploration of the Valley of the Kings, you'll proceed to the Mortuary Temple of El Deir El Bahari, also known as the Northern Monastery. This impressive temple was constructed by the celebrated architect Senmout for his Queen Hatshepsut, one of the most powerful rulers in ancient Egypt. Her reign was marked by significant reforms, particularly in the field of trade.

Later, you will be transferred to Luxor airport in your private vehicle to catch your flight to Cairo. Upon your arrival in Cairo, our representative will be there to warmly welcome you and assist with your transfer to your hotel for check-in and a restful overnight stay.

Day 5: Egyptian Museum, Coptic Cairo, Khan El Khalili, Final Departure

Following breakfast, embark on your Cairo tours to explore the Egyptian Museum. Your personal driver will transport you to Cairo's downtown area, where you'll encounter the captivating masterpieces of the pharaonic era, both inside and outside the Egyptian Museum. This 19th-century architectural gem was erected after the dedicated efforts of the renowned Auguste Mariette. Inside, you'll have the opportunity to marvel at the spectacular treasures from King Tutankhamun's golden collection, featuring jewelry, chariots, beds, caskets, sarcophagi, and the iconic golden mask and throne of the young king.

Subsequently, you will be transferred to the historic district of Old Cairo to visit some of the oldest Christian churches, with a special focus on the Hanging Church of the Holy Virgin Mary. This remarkable church was constructed on the remnants of the ancient Roman fortress of Babylon and is a Greek Orthodox church known for its main nave, two side aisles, and an original pulpit in the center. Discover the ancient icons and relics and explore the crypt where the Holy Virgin Mary and baby Jesus Christ sought refuge for three months beneath the cavern church of St. Sergius. Your Coptic Cairo tour continues with a visit to the Synagogue of Ben Ezra, originally a Coptic Church that was later sold to offset the heavy taxes imposed on the Christian community during the era of Islamic Cairo.

Savor a delectable lunch in a high-quality restaurant offering [Egyptian cuisine](#) before you embark on a journey to the historic [Khan El Khalili](#) market. Here, you'll have the opportunity to immerse yourself in the ambiance of [Islamic Cairo](#) and shop for souvenirs that will serve as lasting reminders of your unforgettable Cairo tours.
