Day 1 Thursday: Arrive Luxor - Luxor East Bank Tours

Following this, you'll marvel at the magnificence of <u>Karnak temple</u>, an awe-inspiring sanctuary dedicated to the Sun God Amun Re, constructed by influential Pharaohs such as Hatshepsut, Seti I, Ramses II, <u>Ramses III</u>, and enhanced by <u>Alexander the great</u>.

Day 2 Friday: Luxor West Bank Tours - Sail to Edfu

Commence your <u>Luxor day tours</u> with a delightful breakfast aboard an Egyptian Nile cruise, setting the stage for exploration on Luxor's West Bank. Discover the highlights, including the renowned Valley of the Kings, housing the tombs of numerous New Kingdom pharaohs. Be captivated by well-preserved frescoes, particularly the trial scene depicting gods like Osiris, Maat, the goddess of justice, and Anubis, the god of the necropolis in ancient Egyptian history.

Embark on a visit to the Hatshepsut Temple, also known as <u>El Deir El Bahari Temple</u>, dedicated to the fifth Pharaoh of the 18th Dynasty and the second female Pharaoh of Egypt. This complex of Pharaonic temples and tombs on the West Bank of the Nile, opposite Luxor, was constructed for Queen Hatshepsut's rituals in the afterlife. The modern Arab name, given in the 7th century AD, reflects its use as a Coptic monastery.

Conclude your Luxor excursions with a tour of the Colossi of Memnon, colossal seated stone statues representing Pharaoh Amenhotep III.

Savor an open-buffet lunch and dinner on your Nile cruise while sailing to Edfu. Spend the night aboard your Nile cruise.

For those seeking an extra adventure, your personal tour guide can arrange a morning hot air balloon ride in Luxor (Optional activity).

Day 3 Saturday: Edfu and Kom Ombo Temples

Following breakfast on the Nile cruise, embark on the Kom Ombo and Edfu tour. Explore the Horus

Temple, also known as Edfu Temple, dedicated to the Egyptian god Horus, son of Isis and Osiris, depicted with a hawk's head on a man's body. Proceed to Kom Ombo to visit the Kom Ombo Temple, constructed for the crocodile-shaped god Sobek from one entrance and dedicated to Haroeris with a falcon head from the other entrance, dating back to the Ptolemaic dynasty. Sail to Aswan, reveling in the picturesque scenery along the Nile River.

Day 4 Sunday: Aswan Sightseeing Tours

Indulge in a sumptuous breakfast before commencing your Aswan day tours, exploring two captivating sites:

Aswan High Dam:
