Itinerary

Day 1: Arrive Cairo, Check-In

Upon your arrival at <u>Cairo International Airport</u>, our representative will greet you and transfer you to your hotel in Cairo or Giza.

Upon arrival at the hotel, the staff will assist you with the check-in process and provide a brief tour of the hotel facilities. After some rest, you'll be well-prepared for your upcoming trip.

Day 2: Siwa Sightseeing Sightseeing

In the leisurely afternoon, unwind at <u>Cleopatra Spring</u>, one of the most renowned hot springs in <u>Siwa Oasis</u>. Enjoy swimming and immersing yourself in the sparkling water, followed by a visit to Fitnas Island to witness the picturesque sunset.

Day 3: A safari over the Egyptian desert to the Great Sand Sea

Begin your Siwa Oasis Desert Safari with a hearty breakfast at the hotel. Your licensed Egyptologist will then guide you on a thrilling 4x4 tour of the Great Sand Sea. Starting with the Mountain of the Dead and exploring the tombs of the oasis' kings, we'll proceed to the enchanting sand dunes and the fossilized corals from the Cambrian era.

Continuing our Egypt Desert Safari journey, we'll visit one of the remarkable locations in the Great Sand Sea—a stunning lake in the heart of the desert. Here, you might have the opportunity to witness flamingo birds, peacefully enjoying the desert's tranquility and bathing in a calming setting.

Following a visit to Dakrour Mountain, experience the exhilaration of sandboarding, offering the thrill of gliding down sand dunes. After sandboarding, unwind in the hot spring known as <u>Bir Wahid</u> to relax your muscles. Conclude <u>the Great Sand Sea</u> Tour by enjoying another breathtaking sunset while sipping Bedouin tea in the midst of the dunes.

Day 5: Giza Pyramids Tour, Egyption museum

After enjoying breakfast at the hotel, a representative from our company will meet you in the lobby to assist you with your <u>Cairo day tours</u>. Your tour will commence with an awe-inspiring visit to the Giza Pyramids, where the sheer size of these colossal structures, built during the Old Kingdom of ancient Egypt's history by the greatest kings and rulers, will leave you astounded.

Explore the Great Pyramid of Cheops, inspired by his father's challenging efforts to construct expansive burial tombs, and the pyramid of King Snefru, the founder of the 4th dynasty and owner of two great pyramids in Dahshur. Proceed to the high plateau for a breathtaking view of the three pyramids, including the pyramids of Chephren, son of Cheops and successor to King Djedefre. Chephren's pyramid is slightly smaller than his father's.

Marvel at the Great Sphinx in Giza, a statue depicting a man with a lion's body, believed to have been created for King Chephren himself as it is located within his funerary complex. You'll have the option to ride a camel on the plateau surrounding the <u>Giza Pyramids</u>. Enter the Valley Temple, where the king underwent mummification as part of the burial process.

Continue your tour in Cairo with a visit to the Egyptian Museum, home to the largest collection of Egyptian antiquities in the world. After the 2-hour tour, head to the Islamic Khan El Khalili area for an immersive walking tour in Cairo, offering a close-up look at Egyptian locals. Enjoy lunch at a high-quality restaurant. Once your Cairo City Tour concludes, you'll be driven back to the hotel for the night.
