Itinerary

Day 1: Friday - Embarkation - Aswan Nile Cruise Tours

Upon your arrival, our representative will warmly welcome you and assist you with the boarding process before lunch. You'll savor a delectable meal onboard the MS Royal Princess Nile Cruise. Afterward, your Egypt Day Tours will commence with a visit to the renowned High Dam in Aswan. This colossal structure holds an astonishing 43,000,000 cubic meters of materials, stretching about 4,000 meters in length and 980 meters in width at its base. Remarkably, it can regulate the flow of water at a rate of about 11,000 cubic meters per second through its 180 sluice gates, serving the purpose of flood control.

During your excursions in Aswan, you'll be transported to the granite quarries that once supplied the ancient Egyptians with the stone blocks used in constructing the awe-inspiring pyramids and temples. Here, you'll encounter the Unfinished Obelisk, believed to have been carved during the reign of the powerful Queen Hatshepsut during the New Kingdom of ancient Egypt.

Next, your driver and guide will lead you to one of the masterpieces of ancient Egypt, the Temple of Goddess Isis, also known as the <u>Temple of Philae</u>. Following this visit, you'll set sail on the Nile, enjoy afternoon tea, and then be greeted with a Captain's welcome cocktail after a fulfilling day of Aswan excursions.

As the day comes to a close, you'll indulge in a delicious dinner aboard your Egypt Nile River Cruise while being treated to an incredible Nubian show. Your overnight stay will be in Aswan.

Day 2: Saturday - Kom Ombo and Edfu Temples

On your second day, your day will kick off with a delightful breakfast onboard your Egypt Nile River Cruise. Your journey will then take you to the fascinating town of <u>Kom Ombo</u>, situated in Aswan Governorate, Upper Egypt. Here, you'll encounter an extraordinary double temple, a relic from the Ptolemaic dynasty dating back to 180–47 BC. Some additional modifications were later made during the Roman period. This remarkable structure is known as the Kom Ombo temple and is shared by two significant deities of the region: the crocodile-shaped god Sobek and Haroeris.

Following your exploration of the Kom Ombo temple, your cruise will continue to Edfu, where you'll enjoy a sumptuous lunch onboard your luxurious Nile cruise from Aswan to Luxor. Upon arrival in Edfu, you'll be guided to visit the Edfu Temple, a masterpiece constructed between 237 and 57 B.C. during the Ptolemaic period.

This temple, dedicated to the falcon-headed god Horus, is believed to stand on the site where the great myth involving the gods Horus and Seth unfolded, according to ancient Egyptian beliefs.

As the day winds down, you'll savor a delectable dinner served onboard the cruise ship. Your next destination is Esna, where you'll have the opportunity to attend an Egyptian Galabeya Party. The 'Galabeya' is a traditional one-piece long dress worn by both men and women in Egypt.

Next on your itinerary is a visit to <u>Karnak Temple</u>, a vast and magnificent complex. Here, you can explore its awe-inspiring architecture and historical significance.

In the evening, you'll relish a delightful dinner onboard the 4 Days Nile River Cruise from Aswan to Luxor, all while enjoying a mesmerizing belly dancing show.
