Itinerary

Day 1: Embarkation in Aswan

A representative from Cairo Top Tours will be waiting for you at the train station or <u>Aswan Airport</u> with a sign with your name upon your arrival.

Your 4-day Nile Cruise tour on Steigenberger MS Minerva from Aswan to Luxor will help you enjoy an amazing journey along the Nile River. We will transfer you to the dock in a private, air-conditioned, nonsmoking car.

Following the boarding and check-in processes, you will first unwind in your cabin before enjoying a delectable open buffet lunch on board. From there, you will begin your touring in Aswan in the following ways:

Aside from the breathtaking view of <u>the high dam</u>, the High Dam is regarded as the most important project in Egypt's modern history and spared the country from the Nile River's frequent floods.

The Unfinished Obelisk:

Continue your Aswan day tour by being driven to the well-known granite quarries, where the ancient Egyptians extracted the stones needed to build the enormous pyramids of Egypt and the vast temples of the new kingdom. You can also explore <u>the Unfinished Obelisk</u>, which is an example of how enormous stones were cut and used for memorial structures.

Temple of Isis:

You will take a Felucca ride to the magnificent <u>Temple of Philae</u>, which was dedicated to the goddess Isis, who was one of the ancient Egyptian goddesses. You will see the Greco-Roman architecture of the temple. This temple is thought to be one of the Sites where the myth of Osiris and Seth took place.

Day 2: Tour to Kom Ombo and Edfu Temples

You will start one of the most amazing <u>Egypt Nile Cruise Tours</u>, the Tour to Kom Ombo and Edfu, after eating breakfast on your Nile Cruise. The boat will sail north to <u>the Kom Ombo Temple</u>. We will visit the Ptolemaic Temple honoring God Sobek as well as Haroeris, which is the local name of one of the incarnations of the god Horus who was worshiped in this region. Your boat will sail to Edfu and your delicious buffet lunch will be served once everyone has had enough time to tour the temple. After arriving at <u>Edfu Temple</u> by horse-drawn carriage, you will see the historic Horus Temple before boarding the boat to travel to Esna, where you may savor your afternoon tea. Another delicious dinner will be served on board in the evening. After returning from your visit to Edfu, you will spend the night aboard your Nile Cruise in Esna, where the entertainment will be an amazing Egyptian Galabeya Party.

Day 3: Luxor Sightseeing Tour

After enjoying your delicious breakfast while the boat sails near Luxor. Get ready for the West Bank of Luxor Tour, which is often regarded as one of the most exciting tours in Luxor.

When you arrive in Luxor, you will disembark to begin your Luxor day tours. You will then visit the rock-cut tombs of <u>the Valley of Kings</u>, which is well-known throughout the world. Here, several pharaohs and kings of the New Kingdom are buried to rest in peace, includin<u>g Ramses the Great</u>, Tutmosis |||, and the golden pharaoh Tutankhamen, whose tomb was found entirely intact in 1922—that is one of the most successful excavations in Egyptian history. You will next visit the spectacular <u>Temple of Queen Hatshepsut</u>, which is one of Luxor's most well-known sights. After that, you will see <u>the historic Colossi of Memnon</u>, which was constructed for King Amenhotep III, and then you will have lunch on the ship again.

We will carry on with our Luxor sightseeing excursions; this time, you will visit <u>the Karnak Temple</u> Complex before seeing the astoundingly well-preserved <u>Luxor Temple</u>. After the incredible East and West Bank day trip, savor a hearty meal and stay an additional night on the cruise ship.
