Itinerary

Day 1: Tour to the High Dam, Philae Temple, and the Unfinished Obelisk

Your professional tour leader will transfer you to the MS Nile Dolphin Nile cruise, which is one of the best Egypt Nile Cruises to start your Aswan day tours as follows: The High Dam in Aswan:

You will see <u>the Aswan High Dam</u> before setting sail. This dam was constructed in 1960 to protect Egypt from the heavy floods that occur there every year and generate enough electricity for such a large country.

Isis Temple:

Resuming your Aswan excursions, you'll see the amazing pillars and engravings at <u>the Philae Temple</u>, which have been preserved for thousands of years, and give us the tale of Horus and Osiris as well as other details about how magnificent and advanced our fathers were. It was regarded as a significant prehistoric Isis cult center.

The Unfinished Obelisk:

Your Aswan to Luxor Nile Cruise includes a visit to the world's largest obelisk, which is known as <u>the</u> <u>Unfinished Obelisk</u>. This Obelisk is located in the granite quarries in Aswan. Egyptologists think that Queen Hatshepsut started to build this obelisk but didn't finish it. After that, you'll be taken to the Nile River Cruise. You will be served lunch and dinner on your MS Nile Dolphin Nile Cruise.

Day 2: Tour to Kom Ombo Temple - Sailing to Edfu

Enjoy a delicious breakfast while sailing the Nile River in Egypt. You will start one of the most unique tours to Kom Ombo. Visit <u>the Kom Ombo Temple</u>, which was constructed in Egypt during the Ptolemaic Kingdom for the god Sobek. From one entrance, a crocodile-shaped deity is worshipped, while from the other, Haroeris, with its falcon-headed head, is honored. You will see some incredibly well-preserved crocodile mummies in the Sobek chapel within the temple. Following your fascinating tour to Kom Ombo, you will be served lunch and dinner on board as you cruise overnight to Edfu.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner

Day 3: Tour to Edfu Temple, Karnak Temple, and Luxor Temple

The Nile cruise ship's breakfast buffet will open early in the morning. Visit the Temple of Horus, also called <u>the Temple of Horus at Edfu</u>, which is one of the biggest Ptolemaic-era temples. One of the gods of ancient Egypt, Horus is the son of Isis and Osiris and the deity of the sky. He is represented by a human body with a hawk head and is also considered to be the defender of monarchy.

After finishing our tour to Edfu, we will start to sail to Esna and Luxor, where we will see two of Egypt's most significant temples: The renowned Luxor temple and <u>the Temple of Karnak</u>, which are regarded as outdoor museums.

Included meals: Breakfast, lunch, and dinner.

Day 4: Valley of the Kings - Hatshepsut Temple - Colossi of Memnon

Luxor hot air balloon ride in the early morning is available as an optional tour.

Breakfast will be served on board your Nile Cruise as your final meal. After disembarking from the Nile cruise, you will meet your guide to begin your day trips to Luxor. Here, you will explore <u>the Valley of</u> <u>the Kings</u>, which is a world heritage site that is home to the magnificent tombs of the New Kingdom pharaohs that were carved into the mountain by the most skilled Egyptian artisans.

Then you will visit the Luxor temple, which was dedicated to <u>Queen Hatshepsut</u>. This temple is also called El Deir El Bahari, who was the second female pharaoh and the fifth of the eighteenth dynasty. During the trips to Luxor, we will also show you the Colossi of Memnon, which are two enormous stone statues of the pharaoh Amenhotep III. Then we will drop you off at Luxor Airport or railway station as you like.
