<u>Itinerary</u>

Day 1: Embarkation in Luxor

Meet our tour guide at the airport in Luxor. He'll be holding a sign bearing the Cairo Top Tours logo and your name. Tipping is not included in the cost of your Egypt Nile River Cruises. Upon arrival in Luxor, you will be driven in a private, air-conditioned, nonsmoking vehicle for approximately thirty minutes to board the Movenpick Royal Lily Nile cruise. This is your opportunity to experience the allure of the river and discover its fascinating monuments and Egyptian history. After checking in and relaxing in your cabin, we will eat lunch on the Nile cruise and then start touring Luxor to visit its main attractions.

You're going to the East Bank of Luxor. The first stop on an Egypt day tour is the complex of Karnak Temples, which was constructed over two millennia ago as a natural museum of ancient Egyptian art, a blueprint of the might and splendor of a golden age, and a wealth of historical information. After that, proceed to the Temple of Luxor, another instance of the New Kingdom Pharaohs' renown. After that, you can unwind on your boat and have a free evening till your delicious dinner is served in the restaurant on the boat. On the first evening of your Egypt Nile River Cruise in Luxor, experience tranquility and tranquility of mind.

Day 2: West Bank tours and sailing to Esna and Edfu

Enjoy your delicious breakfast in the classy dining area of the Egypt Nile River Cruise. Your tour guide will drive you to the west bank to begin your Luxor day trip. We'll disembark from the boat today and explore two of the most well-known sites in Egypt. One must-see stop on any trip to Egypt is the Valley of the Kings, where you can see the rock-carved tombs of the New Kingdom Pharaohs and learn about the practice of mummification in ancient Egypt. We would select the tombs of Thutmose III, Ramses IX, Siptah, and Ramses IV as our top picks.

The Temple of Queen Hatshepsut, also known as <u>El-Dier El Bahari</u>, is dedicated to the sun god Amun Re. We will go there in a miniature train to see the temple, which was built on the precipitous limestone cliffs that rise above the desert in the Deir el-Bahari valley.

After this amazing trip through Luxor, you will be returned to the cruise ship and have lunch while the Movenpick Royal Lily Nile cruise liner is sailing to Esna to bridge the Lock. During tea time on the upper deck of the cruiser, take in the breathtaking view of the stunning Nile valley. When you get to Edfu your oriental supper will be provided on board. There, you will spend the night taking in the belly dance and musical performance while floating on the serene waters of the Nile.

Day 3: Edfu Temple and Kom Ombo Sightseeing

As we travel to Edfu, your breakfast buffet on board the Movenpick Royal Lily Nile cruise ship will begin early in the morning. Visit the well-known <u>Temple of Edfu</u>, one of the biggest temples in Egypt and one of the most lovely, dating back to the Ptolemaic era. It is devoted to the god Horus. Your lunch will be served on board while you enjoy the fascinating views of the Nile, the nature-preserved islands, and all kinds of visiting birds hovering above the city. And fill your eyes with the beauty of these views also during tea time at the spacious sundeck.
