Day 1 Thursday: Arrive Luxor - Luxor East Bank Tours

When you arrive at [Luxor Airport](#), a trained representative from Cairo Top Tours will meet you and assist you in transferring to the Semiramis II Nile Cruise and Luxor East Bank Tours. Begin your fascinating Egypt Day Tour with a visit to [the Luxor Temple](#), a vast structure constructed by numerous Pharaohs to showcase the magnificence of ancient Egyptian craftsmanship. Next, proceed to witness the most magnificent temple ever constructed for the worship of the Sun God during the New Kingdom, Amun Re, at [Karnak Temple](#). This temple boasts enormous pylons, columns, and a grand hypostyle hall. Notable pharaohs who contributed to its construction include Hatshepsut, Seti I, Ramses II, and Ramses III, and [Alexander the Great](#) added his personal touch.

Day 2 Friday: Luxor West Bank Tours - Sail to Edfu

If you asked your own tour guide to make the arrangements, you may take an optional morning [hot air balloon ride](#) over Luxor.

Starting with your morning meal on your Egypt Nile River Cruise, begin your Luxor day tours by seeing the main attractions of the Luxor West Bank Tours, such as [the Valley of the Kings](#), where the majority of the Pharaohs of the New Kingdom are buried. The vivid colors of the wall paintings will excite you, especially the judgment scene where you will see a variety of deities, including the goddess of justice, Goddess Maat, the goddess of the afterlife, and the god of the necropolis, Anubis.

Discover [the Temple of Hatshepsut](#), also known as El Deir El Bahari Temple. Hatshepsut was the second female Pharaoh to rule Egypt and the fifth Pharaoh of the 18th Dynasty. After your Luxor excursions, you will tour [the Colossi of Memnon](#), which are two enormous seated stone statues that represent Amenhotep III, but are not in very good condition. Savor the delicious meal that is served at the buffet.

Day 3 Saturday: Edfu and Kom Ombo Temples

Following breakfast on the Nile cruise, you will begin the Kom Ombo and Edfu trip with your knowledgeable guide at your side to see Horus Temple, also known as [Edfu Temple](#), God The Egyptian god of the sky, Horus, was the son of Osiris and Isis and was represented by a hawk's head on a man's body. Subsequently, set sail for Kom Ombo to see [the Kom Ombo Temple](#). Built during the Ptolemaic era, one entrance was dedicated to the crocodile-shaped god Sobek, while the other entrance honored Haroeris, the falcon-headed god. As you sail into Aswan, take in the breathtaking views of the Nile River.

Day 4 Sunday: Aswan Sightseeing Tours

High Dam in Aswan:

It is one of the best excursions in Aswan and was founded in the 1960s by President Nasser to protect Egypt from the annual floods.
