Day 1: Saturday - Embarkation Luxor East Bank Tours

We will pick you up from any point in Luxor, such as <u>the international airport</u>, and the first day's activities will include checking into your cozy cabin on the Egypt Nile River Cruise before lunch. Divine Sonesta Moon Nile Journey

Then, enjoy your Luxor day trip with your Egyptologist guide as you see the Karnak Temple, which is regarded as the crown jewel of the ancient Egyptian temples constructed primarily during the New Kingdom.

He will also lead you to the Luxor Temple, which was started by Amenhotep the Third and built by a number of rulers.

You will take part in the Belly Dancing Show and afternoon tea after finishing your Luxor East Bank Tours before dinner is served on board. Take in the music in the lounge.

Day 2: Sunday - Luxor West Bank Tours - Sail o Edfu

Take an early morning <u>hot air balloon flight in Luxor</u> to get a bird's-eye perspective of the stunning city.

You will begin your Egypt Day Tours in Luxor with an early wake-up call. After breakfast on board your Egypt Nile River Cruise, you will see the final stages of the royal tombs, which were carved into the western mountain that would later be known as the Valley of the Kings by the Pharaohs of the new kingdom. You will also learn about mummification and the various Egyptian burial customs.

Proceed with your Luxor tours as your guide takes you to view the Colossi of Memnon and covers Queen Hatshepsut's Temple, the ancient Egyptian temple dedicated to the legendary female pharaoh.

After lunch on board as you sail to Edfu, have afternoon tea. While listening to music in the lounge, dinner is served on board.

Day 3: Monday - Edfu and Kom Ombo Temples - Sail to Aswan

After a hearty breakfast and an early wake-up call, take a fantastic tour to Kom Ombo and Edfu, where you can see the Edfu Temple, which was constructed for the worship of the god Horus. After that, sail to Kom Ombo while eating lunch on board.

Enjoy a fascinating tour of the Kom Ombo Temple, which was formerly home to the gods Sobek and

Horaeris. Then, continue sailing toward Aswan while savoring a delectable afternoon tea and dinner aboard.

The Galabiya Party will take place as part of Cairo Top Tours' entertainment program.

Day 4: Tuesday - Aswan Tours

The trip begins at seven in the morning with breakfast on board the ship. Next, you will disembark from your Egypt Nile River Cruise and enjoy Aswan day tours, visiting the High Dam, the largest but not the first dam built in Egypt. After that, you'll head to the Granite Quarries to see the largest Unfinished Obelisk, which, contrary to what some scholars claim, was never completed before Queen Hatshepsut died.

During your Aswan excursions, the Temple of Philae will be your next stop. Dedicated to the worship of Goddess Isis, it was built in the Greco-Roman style.

Day 5: Wednesday - Disembarkation

Our tour guide will transport you to the Aswan airport, or to any other desired drop-off point, following your breakfast on board the Luxor to Aswan Nile Cruise boat.
