#### **Itinerary**

## Day1- Tour To Pyramids Of Giza ,the Egyptian museum and old cairo.

Our tour guide will pick you up from your accommodation in Cairo or Giza at 8:00 am to begin your half-day excursion to the Giza pyramid and Sphinx.

Your first stop will be the Great Pyramid of Giza, also known as the Pyramid of Khufu or Cheops, the oldest and largest pyramid in the Giza complex, and the only intact Wonder of the Ancient World.

Next, we'll visit the Pyramid of Khafre, the second tallest and largest pyramid at Giza, housing the tomb of Pharaoh Khafre, who ruled from 2558 to 2532 BC. Then, we'll proceed to the Pyramid of Mykerinus.

During our visit to the King Chephren <u>Valley Temple</u>, you'll have a closer look at the Great Sphinx, an iconic guardian perched atop a vast burial site, featuring the heads of Pharaoh Khafre and a lion.

After exploring the pyramids, enjoy a camel ride nearby.

Our next stop is the <u>Egyptian Museum</u>, home to a priceless collection of over 250,000 authentic artifacts dating back 5000 years, including a special exhibit dedicated to Tutankhamen's treasures discovered in 1920.

We'll then visit the <u>Saladin Citadel</u>, constructed by Salah al-Din in 1183 AD as a defense against Crusader soldiers. Today, it's a well-preserved historic district with mosques and museums, offering sweeping views of Cairo.

Lunch will be served at a restaurant in Old Cairo.

In Old Cairo, marvel at landmarks like the Hanging Church, Ben Ezra Synagogue, Church of St. Barbara, and Church of Abu Serga, one of Cairo's oldest Coptic churches.

Explore Khan el-Khalili, one of the oldest bazaars in the Middle East, with its labyrinthine alleys serving as Cairo's bustling commercial center since the 14th century.

Finally, return to your Cairo hotel for an overnight stay.

## Day2- Cairo to the Baharyia oasis and white desert

Departing from your lodging in Cairo or Giza, your adventure begins with a journey to the <u>Bahariya Oasis</u>, situated approximately 350 kilometers east of Cairo. After a four-hour drive, you'll reach the White Desert, where your safari guide awaits. Board a 4x4 Jeep and embark on an exploration of this mesmerizing landscape.

Traverse the barren desert terrain, adorned with a fine layer of black powder that blankets its mountains, hills, and dunes. Enjoy a rejuvenating break at <u>El Haize oasis</u>, located 37 kilometers from Bawiti, where you can indulge in a hot spring bath, known for its therapeutic effects on the body and mind.

En route, stop at Crystal Mountain, known locally as Gebel al-Izzaz, renowned for its quartzite crystals that glisten in the sunlight, earning it the moniker "the Jewel of the Desert." Continue your journey to the Valley of Agabat, nestled within the heart of the White Desert, where ancient limestone formations sculpted by time create a surreal landscape. Engage in thrilling activities such as sandboarding and 4x4 Jeep exploration of Wadi el Agabat.

Next, venture into the White Desert National Park, renowned for its stunning white rock formations that resemble various animals and structures, including camels, mushrooms, tents, and even a sphinx.

After capturing the breathtaking scenery with memorable photographs, return to your accommodations in Cairo, concluding your unforgettable desert safari experience.

## **Day3- Cairo to Alexandria**

Private tour of <u>Alexandria from Cairo</u>, commencing at 7:00 am as one of our knowledgeable Egyptologists picks you up from your Cairo hotel. Traveling 220 kilometers northwest, you'll arrive in Alexandria to begin your day of exploration.

Commence your excursion with a visit to the Alexandria Catacombs, an awe-inspiring site steeped in history. The Kom el Shoqafa catacomb, believed to have been constructed in the second century A.D., served as a burial site for over 200 years, showcasing a remarkable blend of civilizations from Alexandria's rich past, including the legacy of Egyptian kings dating back over 4,000 years.

Next, proceed to Pompey's Pillar, a towering red granite column standing at 25 meters tall. The pillar's origin is steeped in legend, with tales suggesting it may have been erected as a tribute to the Roman general Pompey or Diocletian the Great. It stands as the tallest ancient structure in Alexandria, offering a glimpse into the city's illustrious past.

Continue your journey to the Qaitbay Citadel, a 15th-century fortress constructed by Mamluk Sultan Qaitbay to defend against Crusader invasions. This remarkable Islamic architectural marvel incorporates remnants of the ancient Lighthouse of Alexandria, originally built by Ptolemy II in the third century B.C.

Enjoy a delicious lunch at an authentic Egyptian restaurant before proceeding to your next destination, <u>the Library of Alexandria</u>. Reopened in October 2002, the library pays homage to its prestigious past while serving as a hub for arts, history, philosophy, and science. Its stunning architecture and diverse range of activities make it a symbol of dialogue, understanding, and intellectual discourse.

Conclude your day of exploration and return to your Cairo hotel, where you'll spend the night, reflecting on the wonders of Alexandria.

### **Day4- Final Departure**

Following breakfast, your tour leader will collect you from your Cairo hotel and assist with the check-out process. Subsequently, you will be transferred to Cairo international airport for your departure.
