Itinerary

Day 1: Cairo Arrival

Upon your arrival at <u>Cairo international airport</u>, our tour guide will greet you and escort you to your hotel in a private car. Take this opportunity to relax, enjoy a delicious meal, and recharge for the adventures awaiting you the next day.

Day 2: Day Tour to Pyramids and Dahshur

After enjoying a delightful warm meal, your journey commences with a visit to the majestic <u>Pyramids of Giza</u>. These ancient wonders stand as the most monumental relics of antiquity, bearing witness to the remarkable prowess of the pharaohs who commissioned their construction. Among them, the Great Pyramid, also known as the Pyramid of Khufu, reigns supreme as one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World. Constructed by King Khufu during his reign from 2790 to 2767 BC, it epitomizes the architectural marvels of ancient Egypt.

Following this awe-inspiring visit, savor a lunch with the magnificent pyramids as your backdrop. Next, venture to Dahshur, situated near the Giza pyramids, where you'll encounter yet more remarkable pyramids. Located approximately 40 kilometers southwest of Cairo, <u>Dahshur</u>marks the southern terminus of the pyramid complex extending from Giza. Excavations in this area have unearthed seven pyramids, along with expansive tomb complexes crafted for queens and nobles spanning from the Memphis era to the Thirteenth Dynasty.

Afterward, return in a private car for a delectable dinner and a restful night's stay.

Day 3: Tour to The National Museum of Civilization and El Refaai Mosque

After enjoying a hearty breakfast, prepare for our next adventure.

Our first stop will be <u>The National Museum of Civilization</u>, a vast museum spanning 23,235 square meters of exhibition space located in the ancient city of Fustat, now part of Cairo, Egypt. Partially opened in February 2017, the museum boasts a collection of 50,000 artifacts, offering a comprehensive glimpse into Egyptian civilization from prehistoric times to the present day.

Following our museum visit, indulge in a delicious lunch at a nearby traditional restaurant.

Our tour then continues to the renowned <u>Sultan Hassan El Refaai Mosque</u>, one of Cairo's most famous ancient mosques. Commissioned by Khushiar Hanim, the mother of Khedive Ismail, in 1286 AH / 1869 AD, the mosque's construction was overseen by Hussein Pasha Fahmy. Although halted in 1298 AH / 1880 AD, the mosque stands as a testament to the architectural prowess of its time.

Afterward, return to the hotel for dinner and overnight accommodation.

Day 4: Flight to Luxor

After breakfast, prepare to depart for Luxor. Upon arrival, take some time to relax and check in at your hotel.

Next, we'll embark on a visit to the awe-inspiring <u>Karnak Temple</u>. This monumental complex, renowned worldwide, boasts an impressive array of temple ruins, chapels, colossal columns, and other architectural wonders, located just 3 km from Luxor in Egypt.

Following our exploration of Karnak Temple, we'll proceed to the majestic <u>Great Temple of Luxor</u>. Situated on the eastern bank of the Nile River in the city of Luxor, this expansive temple complex dates back to 1400 BC. Dedicated to the worship of Amun-Ra, his consort Mut, and their son Khonsu, it is often referred to as the Theban Trinity.

Finally, return to the hotel for lunch and immerse yourself in the enchanting atmosphere of Luxor by night.

Day 5: Visit to Luxor Attractions

Today's itinerary in Luxor begins with a visit to its most renowned attractions. We'll start with the Valley of Kings, a secluded desert valley chosen as the final resting place for kings to safeguard their tombs from ancient theft. Moving on, we'll explore the Valley of the Queens, once a significant burial site for queens, princes, and nobles during the 18th and 19th dynasties.

Following our exploration, enjoy a relaxing lunch amidst historical surroundings. Then, we'll journey to <u>el-Deir el-Bahari</u>, a collection of pharaonic temples and tombs on the west bank of the Nile, constructed by Queen Hatshepsut for her afterlife rituals.

Continuing our tour, we'll visit the iconic <u>Colossi of Memnon</u>, two imposing statues originally placed at the entrance of an ancient funerary temple dedicated to King Amenhotep III.

Finally, return to the hotel to unwind and recharge after an eventful day of exploration.

Day 6: Visit to Edfu and Kom Ombo Temples

On this day, our Luxor tour concludes with visits to two remarkable temples. First, we'll explore <u>The great temple of Edfu</u>, also known as Hadat or Bahdatti in ancient times. Dedicated to the deity Horus, it stands as a testament to ancient Egyptian religious beliefs.

Next, we'll venture to <u>the temple of Komombo</u>, situated strategically atop a hill overlooking the Nile River. Originally known as Pasobek, this temple served as the sacred abode of Sobek, the crocodile god, since predynastic times.

Throughout the day, all meals including breakfast, lunch, and dinner are provided as part of the tour package.

Day 7: Aswan Attractions

After breakfast, prepare to journey to Aswan in our comfortable private air-conditioned vehicles. There, you'll witness the impressive High Dam, whose history dates back to the 11th century AD. Originally conceived by engineer Ibn al-Haytham, this monumental structure was built to control the flooding of the Nile.

Our exploration of Aswan concludes with a visit to the Nubian village, with roots tracing back over a century to the construction of the ancient Aswan reservoir. Established on the west bank of the river, this village provided a safe haven for its inhabitants amidst the annual floods.

Later, return to the hotel in Luxor. Breakfast, lunch, and dinner are all included as part of our tour program.

Day 8: Travel Back To Cairo

After checking out from the hotel, you'll board our arranged transportation to catch your flight back to Cairo International Airport. Take this opportunity to relax and rejuvenate before embarking on our next adventure tomorrow.

Day 9: Fayum Day Tour

After enjoying a traditional Egyptian breakfast, you'll prepare for an exciting day ahead in Egypt, accompanied by our knowledgeable tour guide.

In Cairo, your journey begins as you board a private van at your hotel. Relax as you travel 105 kilometers southwest to Fayoum, an Egyptian city known as the capital of Fayoum Governorate. Divided by the Bahr Youssef Canal, Fayoum boasts two distinct residential neighborhoods.

Upon arrival, your first stop will be the mesmerizing <u>Lake of Qarun</u>, also known as the Pond of Qarun. Situated in Fayoum, this expansive lake is one of Egypt's largest natural lakes. Learn about its rich history as you explore its surroundings.

After a well-deserved rest and lunch break, your tour continues with a visit to Wadi El Rayan Reserve. Located in the southwestern part of Fayoum Governorate, Wadi El Rayan features the upper and lower lakes, the picturesque waterfalls area, and the scenic Jabal al Rayan.

As your driver transports you back to your hotel in Cairo, you'll conclude your memorable tour filled with captivating experiences.

Day 10: Visit To Bahariya Oasis and The White Desert

After enjoying breakfast at the hotel, you'll embark on a journey to Bahariya Oasis in our private air-conditioned car. Situated in the Western Desert of Egypt, this oasis belongs to the Giza Governorate and is located 365 kilometers southwest of Giza. Accessible via the Cairo-Wahat Desert Road, <u>Bahariya Oasis</u> encompasses a depression spanning over 2,000 square kilometers, boasting approximately 400 warm and cold mineral and sulfur springs. At its heart lies the city of Bawiti.

Continuing our adventure, we'll proceed to the mesmerizing White Desert. Encompassing an area of 3010 square kilometers, this unique landscape features stunning white formations, making it a protected desert and natural landmark. Known for its karst Kama phenomenon, <u>The White Desert</u> serves as an open museum for studying the desert environment. We'll set up camp here for the night.

Throughout the program, breakfast, lunch, and dinner are all provided, ensuring a seamless and enjoyable experience.

Day 11: Back to Cairo
