Next, you will be transferred to <u>Tahrir Square</u> Tahrir Square is the largest field in Cairo, Egypt, at the beginning of its establishment it was named after Ismailia Square, after Khedive Ismail, then the name changed to "Tahrir Square"; it was related to liberation from colonialism in the 1919 revolution and then the name was officially established in the July 23 Revolution in 1952. , . you will enjoy there <u>the Egyptian</u> <u>Museum</u> tour to see the different periods of antiquities including the child King Tutankhamun's treasures, the 2 floors building contains more than 120,000 artifacts between huge statues, golden coffins, sarcophagi, and mummies.

Continue your Cairo trips right after you enjoy the tasty lunch in one of the local restaurants in Cairo, transfer then to the oldest market in Egypt, If you visit Egypt, you can go to Khan El Khalili, which was once the site of a mausoleum known as the tomb of el -Za'faraan (Saffron Tomb), which was the Fatimid caliphs' burial site and is now one of the most popular markets in Islamic Cairo.

Day 3: Cairo to Alexandria, Alexandria Tours

Continue to see the site where the <u>Pompey Pillar</u> The pillar of Pompey is associated fine arts marvel settled amidst the ruins of the Serapeum within the Egyptian coastal town of Alexandria. it's one of the most important places of Antiquity. The Serapeum was an associate Greek temple that was designed throughout the reign of the <u>Ptolemaic kingdom</u> in Egypt and was dedicated to the new god idolized in Alexandria and everyone over Egypt, Serapis who was believed to be the defender of Alexandria.

Continue to visit the <u>Citadel of</u> he Citadel of Qaitbey was built in the 15th century on Pharos island, where the <u>Pharos Lighthouse of Alexandria</u> stood, it was built on the ruins of the ancient Lighthouse of Alexandria which is a unique location, overlooking the Port of Alexandria.

Sultan al-Ashraf Abu al-Nasr Qaytbay began the construction of this castle in the year 882 AH in the place of the ancient lighthouse of Alexandria, which was destroyed after the devastating earthquake that occurred in the year 702 AH during the reign of Sultan al-Nasir Muhammad ibn Qalawun.

We will pass by the <u>Bibliotheca Alexandrina</u> Its destruction has been attributed to totally different actors, however, no version has been tried, the sole clear issue is that it finally disappeared, and it absolutely was not till 1987 that a world project wanted to rescue the cultural significance of the location and therefore the image it represents, began the legendary collective imagined library of humanity. UNESCO coordinated the project and eventually, the name the Alexandria Library, it absolutely was formally opened in 1996.

You will have a fresh seafood lunch in a restaurant overlooking the harbor before being transferred to the hotel in Alexandria for check-in.

Day 4: Alexandria to El Alamein

Enjoy your breakfast at the hotel in <u>Alexandria</u> before making the check-out and transfer to El Alamein to visit the <u>El Alamein War Cemetery</u>, that exhibits incredible things that date back to when the two battles took place in the region between October and November 1942.
