Itinerary

Day 1- Cairo- Siwa oasis

We will pick you up from Cairo airport and drive you to Siwa Oasis in a modern, air-conditioned car. Along the way, we'll make a stop for a coffee break. Upon arrival at Siwa Oasis, our tour leader will assist you with the check-in process at your hotel, allowing you to relax and settle in for the night.

Day 2- Discover siwa oasis

Hotel breakfast is available.

Pickup from the hotel begins at 7:00 am. Your first stop in Siwa today will be the Alexander the Great Temple, also known as the Temple of the Oracle. Legend has it that Alexander consulted the Siwan oracle here to confirm his divine lineage as the son of Zeus. Afterward, we'll head to the salt lake area.

Next, we'll visit the Spring of the Sun, famously known as <u>Cleopatra's bath</u>, where myth suggests Cleopatra once swam. Then, we'll proceed to Umm Ubaydah or the Amun Temple, situated approximately 200 meters from the <u>Temple of the Oracle</u>. This temple was constructed by Pharaoh Nectanebo of the 30th Dynasty. Finally, we'll visit Gebel Al Mawta and savor a Siwan meal at the Abdo Restaurant.

Following lunch, you'll have the opportunity to swim in the salt lake for a unique floating experience. Later in the day, we'll explore the desert, venturing into the Great Sand Sea aboard a Jeep 4x4. You'll also have the chance to experience the hot and cold springs of Bir Wahid.

As dusk falls, we'll enjoy some traditional Bedouin tea before either setting up camp for the night and indulging in a barbecue dinner, or returning to your hotel. Siwa offers charming eco-lodges for accommodation if you prefer not to camp.

Day 3- Siwa oasis tours

Breakfast will be served at the camp at 7:00 am, followed by a drive back to Siwa Oasis as per Egypt 360. From there, we'll proceed to the conical Mountain of the Dead, located just over a kilometer north of Shali. Prior to this, we'll visit the Shali Fort and allocate some free time for shopping. At Gebel Al-Mawta, you'll find four tombs worth exploring, carved into the mountain's side and dating back to the Ptolemaic, Roman, and 26th Dynasty periods.

Afterwards, we'll visit Fatnas Lake. Accessible by bicycle or on foot from Birket Siwa, the small island of Fatnas offers stunning views of Gebel Bayda and Hamra, forming a picturesque backdrop to the west. It's an ideal spot to relax and watch the sunset over the lake. As you stroll through the garden, you'll encounter various trees, including banana, date, and olive trees. Finally, we'll drive you back to your accommodation.

Day 4 :Siwa to Cairo

You may use Siwa more before moving on to Cairo. Try some of the renowned dates, olives, jellies, and syrups from Siwa as well. The list also includes calming and therapeutic herbs, teas, well-known lamps, and products made completely of salt from the Siwa salt lakes. then transfer you to your cairo hotel.

Day 5- tour to giza pyramids and egyption museum

Your day begins with a pickup from your hotel in Cairo by one of our knowledgeable tour guides, who will then transfer you to the Giza pyramids in a private, modern vehicle to commence your full-day trip. At the Giza Pyramids, you'll visit the Great Pyramid of King Cheops, also known as the "Famous Pyramids of Egypt." Following this, enjoy a 20-minute camel ride to delve deeper into the country's history.

Next, your guide will lead you to a panoramic vantage point where you can admire all the pyramids at once. Afterwards, you'll be driven to the Valley Temple, also known as the "Mummification Temple," where King Chephren's body was mummified. Here, our guide will assist you in capturing excellent photographs, selecting the best spots for those special moments.

Lunch will be provided at a nearby restaurant, with drinks available for purchase. Following lunch, the tour continues to Cairo City Center from the <u>Giza pyramids</u>, where you'll visit the Egyptian Museum, one of the largest museums globally, housing a plethora of genuine statues and the treasures of King Tutankhamun. Finally, after the museum visit, you'll be driven back to your hotel.
