#### <u>Itinerary</u>

### **Day1- arrive fayoum**

In the early morning, our tour guide will collect you from your accommodation in Cairo and drive you approximately 95km to the <u>Fayoum Oasis</u>. Known as the focal point of religious reverence for the crocodile god Sobek in ancient Egyptian culture, the oasis boasts around 200 immense waterwheels scattered throughout. The iconic Great Seven Waterwheels will be among the first sights to captivate your attention.

Continuing on, you'll encounter <u>Qaron's Lake</u>, Egypt's largest saltwater lake, acclaimed as the world's oldest natural lake. Surrounding the lake, you may spot various fruits, vegetables, and a diverse array of migratory birds seeking refuge during the winter months. It's an ideal spot to unwind after a day of exploration. Following this, we'll pause for a picnic lunch before heading to <u>Wadi al-Rayan</u>, a designated Protected Area since 1989. This destination promises an exhilarating yet serene day trip, with numerous lakes perfect for swimming, diving, or simply soaking in the stunning vistas.

We'll conclude the day by returning you to Fayoum Hotel for an overnight stay.

## Day2- fayoum - cairo

After enjoying breakfast in the morning, you'll head to the "Wadi Hitan," also known as the <u>Valley of Whales</u>. This site earned UNESCO World Heritage status in July 2005 due to its abundant fossils, some dating back 200 million years to a time when the desert was submerged underwater. Among the notable fossils are bones and skeletons of whales and sea cows, with several incomplete skeletons displayed in the park's open area.

Following this fascinating excursion, you'll travel a short distance south of Wadi El Rayyan Road to Mudawara Mountain for a visit. While not a true mountain, Mudawara Mountain boasts a striking layered appearance and captivating symmetry.

Next, you'll be driven to Karanis, an ancient ruin dating back to the Ptolemaic era, where you'll find Roman, Coptic, and Early Islamic monuments. Finally, we'll return you to your hotel in Cairo.
