Day 1: Arrive Cairo, Egypt

When you arrive at [Cairo International Airport](#), our representative will be waiting for you with a sign bearing your name. He will then escort you to your hotel for a hassle-free check-in and go over your 11 Day Egypt Itinerary with you. He will also set up your pick-up time for each day tour day by day and ensure that you receive the best and most enjoyable service possible as part of your Egypt tour package.

Day 2: Pyramids and Cairo Tours

After having your pleasant breakfast at your hotel, your Egyptologist tour guide will meet you at the hotel Starting with [the Giza Pyramids](#) tours, were built during the Fourth Dynasty of the [Old Kingdom](#) in ancient Egypt. Explore the Giza Necropolis area to see the Great Sphinx of Giza, which was carved into the rock to resemble a lion with a human head to represent both strength and intelligence. It is the largest sphinx in all of Egypt. You'll have enough time to ride a camel and snap pictures to remember these enjoyable day trips from Cairo.

Continue your [Egyptian Museum tour](#), which displayed about 120.000 artifacts from mummies, sarcophagi, ceramics, jewelry, and the most famous collection of [King Tutankhamun](#)'s treasures. After lunch in a reputable restaurant. You will be transferred by your private guide and professional driver to this historic part which is famous by the name Coptic Cairo.

We will take you to visit [the Hanging Church](#) which is dedicated to the Holy Virgin Mary and it is called in Arabic Al Moallaqa which is translated in English as the hanging or the suspended church because it has no foundations, and they built it on top of an old Roman fortress of Babylon, and the Abu Serga Church. You will then need to travel a short distance to see this magnificent church, which is among Egypt's most historic and significant structures and commemorates the visit of the holy family. Finally, you'll visit the historic Jewish Synagogue of [Ben Ezra](#) with the help of our Egyptologist guide.

Day 3: White Desert Tour

After having your delicious breakfast, you will be escorted by your Egyptologist guide to transfer to [the White Desert](#). The limestone and layer of chalk that partially cover the entire white desert land are the sources of the name "white Desert." Even at night, it is very white, magical, and charming. Because the oasis is famous for its palm trees and fruit gardens, you will see the golden sand dunes, the salt lake, and enjoy the green, lush date palm groves! then, after passing through the Black Desert, we proceed to the White Desert.

You will visit [the Valley of El Haize](#), about 50km to the south of Bawiti, and the central village of [Bahariya Oasis](#). Stop to see the quartz crystal at Crystal Mountain. It's located about 160 km from Bahariya oasis, and it's also called the jewel of the desert because it's made of more than 12 types of crystal. and the fabulous [Valley of Agabat](#). It's a great thing to camp in the White Desert. Enjoy your delicious dinner during the marvelous sunset.

Day 4: Bahariya Oasis Tour

Before your White Desert tour comes to an end, eat breakfast in the desert. Then, transfer to the hot springs area, where you can see a variety of beautiful things like mushrooms, chickens, rabbits, trees, and tents. You can also enjoy taking pictures of the amazing limestone rock formations. return to Bahariya Oasis after that. Prepare yourself because our tour guide will transport you from Bahariya to your hotel in Cairo, where you will spend the night in a luxurious air-conditioned vehicle.

Day 5: Cairo to Aswan - Aswan Sightseeing Tours

After eating breakfast, you'll head to [Cairo International Airport](#) to catch your flight to Aswan. At Aswan Airport, our representative will welcome you and help you through security. You'll then meet your English-speaking tour guide to begin your Aswan sightseeing tours, which will take you to see the Aswan High Dam.

The Lake Nasser reservoir, named after the former Egyptian President Nasser, was created by the Aswan [High Dam](#), which was begun in 1960 and finished in 1971. It contains more than 155 cubic meters of water and was filled in 1979.

It was built dedicated to worshipping [the Goddess Isis](#), and it was one of the last residual temples where the ancient Egyptian religion was practiced after the spreading of Christianity in Egypt.

After that, you will transfer to your hotel in Aswan for check-in and overnight.

Day 6: Edfu Temple - Overnight in Luxor

Enjoy your breakfast at the hotel, then you will check out and meet your tour guide to start your visit to explore [the Temple of Edfu](#). Edfu is the site of the famous Ptolemaic Temple of [Horus](#) and has an ancient settlement that goes back as early as 3000 B.C., It was known back in the Hellenistic period as Koine Greek or the Biblical Greek, or in Latin as Apollonopolis Magna as the chief deity of the region, [God Horus](#), was known in Latin as Apollo.

Day 7: Luxor Temple - Luxor Museum

Visit [the Luxor Temple](#) after a sumptuous breakfast at your hotel. Visit the Luxor Museum after you see it. It was constructed on the East Bank of the River Nile by King Amenhotep III in the early days of the new kingdom, about 3400 years ago.

The Luxor Museum is regarded as one of the most important locations that contains the widest variety of ancient artifacts. This museum, which is located on the Nile River Corniche in the heart of Luxor, opened to the public in 1975, and its collection was similarly light and uncomplicated.

It was opened to the public in 1975, inside [this great museum](#) you will enjoy watching the ancient Egyptian artifacts, especially of King Amenhotep III, in addition, to Coptic monuments from the 5th century and also Islamic pieces from the mamluk time. Transfer back to your hotel in Luxor overnight.

Day 8: Luxor West Bank Tours

Enjoy your breakfast, then you will transfer to see the most interesting sites by visiting the Luxor West Bank Tour. First, you will see the Colossi of Memnon, two massive statues of Pharaoh Amenhotep III, who ruled Egypt during [the 18th Dynasty](#). They symbolize prosperity, wealth, and economic and artistic grandeur, marking a new era in Egypt's history.

You will visit [the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut](#), it was built by the strongest woman who ruled Egypt in the ancient time, [Queen Hatshepsut](#). Then continue on to Valley of the Kings to witness its greatness. Nearly 70 pharaohs who ruled Egypt during the new kingdom are buried in the Valley of the Kings, which is a small valley of common, red rock that is hidden beneath the ground.

Then you will transfer to [Hurghada](#) for check-in at your hotel for overnight.
