Day 1: Arrival in Cairo/ Check-in

The tour guide will help you through the check-in process and ensure that everything is in order, from the room to the minute details of your six-day itinerary in Egypt. If there is anything you need to include, amend, or update, you can ask him to do that. Once you arrive at the Cairo International Airport, you will be met and assisted by our representative to be transferred in an exclusive air-conditioned car to your hotel in Cairo.

Enjoy your time at the hotel during your first visit, and if you have time, think about attending the magnificent Sound and [Light Show at the Giza Pyramids](#). This opera-like performance tells the story of ancient Egypt through the voice of the Great Sphinx as the impressive Giza Pyramids are illuminated at night in the peace of the desert.

Day 2: Giza Pyramids Tour/ Egyptian Museum/ Coptic Cairo Tour

After early morning breakfast at the hotel, you will be ready to meet your private Egyptologist guide in the hotel lobby to begin your tour of [the pyramids of Giza](#). On the way to [the Giza necropolis](#). Upon arrival at the Giza Plateau, you will see the three pyramids were built during [the Fourth Dynasty](#) of the Old Kingdom in ancient Egypt. You will have a great opportunity to ride camels through the pyramids of Giza (optional), and your Bedouin guide will take mesmerizing photos for you while you hold onto the pyramids with your hands.

You will visit [the Valley Temple](#), where the king was mummified as part of the funerary rite. The renowned statue of the humanoid lion known as [the Great Sphinx](#) has stood in front of the temple for centuries and protected the necropolis. Your day tours to Cairo continue to see the largest collection of Egyptian artifacts at the [Egyptian Museum](#), the building itself is considered a monument as it was built over 200 years ago. But the most interesting among the exhibits are those that were discovered in the early 1900s for the golden king Tutankhamun.

Continuing your tour, you will transfer by private car to a place known as Coptic Cairo, where you will witness the oldest churches not only in Egyptian history but also in the history of Christianity. It was built on the ruins of the Roman fortress of Babylon, some places were consecrated by the stay of the Holy Family, such as the Hanging Church of St. Mary, which was built suspended from two towers of the fortress, accompanied by the Church of St. Sergius or the Cave Church, and [the Ben Ezra Synagogue](#). Enjoy lunch at a good restaurant during or after your tour of Cairo.

You will then be transferred back to your hotel.

Day 3: Fly to Aswan/ Embark your Nile Cruise Boat

Transfer to [Cairo International Airport](#) for your flight to Aswan. Upon arrival in Aswan, your tour guide will be waiting to welcome you and help you board your 5-star Nile cruise boat before lunch. You can also enjoy your time on the boat by watching the Nubian folkloric show, and dinner will be served as well before spending the night in Aswan.

Day 4 : Aswan Tours/ Kom Ombo Temple

After enjoying a delicious breakfast on your Nile Cruise vessel, begin your Aswan Day tours by being transferred to see one of the largest projects in Egypt's modern history, [the Aswan High Dam](#), which was constructed in the 1960s to protect the country from severe floods that occurred every year. Next, you will visit the stunning Philae Temple overlooking the Nile, which was constructed for the worship of Goddess Isis, the wife of Osiris, in accordance with ancient Egyptian religion. continue your Aswan Excursions to the granite quarries where the pharaohs used to cut and transport huge stone blocks that were used in building the impressive pyramids of Egypt, and the magnificent temples which were built by the kings of the new kingdom.

Back to the Nile cruise to begin sailing to [Kom Ombo](#), your lunch will be served before meeting your guide to enjoy an unusual tour to the Temple of Kom Ombo, dedicated to [God Sobek](#). The Nile Cruise vessel will sail to Edfu while dinner is served and overnight aboard the boat at Edfu.

Day 5 : Edfu Temple/ Luxor Excursions

Your buffet breakfast will be served aboard the Nile Cruise, and then you will meet with the tour guide to go on the sightseeing tour to the [Temple of Horus in Edfu](#), which is the site of the famous Ptolemaic Temple of Horus and has an ancient settlement that dates back as early as 3000 B.C. The entrance to the temple is guarded by a sizable granite statue of Horus. The Double Crown of Upper and Lower Egypt is placed atop it. You will return to the Nile Cruise ship and begin sailing to Luxor, the final city on the Egypt Nile Cruise tours, after learning everything there is to know about Edfu. Both your lunch and afternoon tea will be served on board.

The ship will provide a fine dinner for you that evening, and after that, there will be a fantastic Galabya party.

Day 6 : Luxor to Cairo/ Final Departure

On the 6th day of your tours in Egypt, you will have your breakfast on board, then embark on your deluxe Nile cruise and start your Luxor day tours. We will visit the [Valley of the Kings](#), where the pharaohs of the 18th, 19th, and [20th dynasties](#) chose their eternal restingplaces. then the Colossi of Memnon and the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut, known as the El Deir El Bahari temple. Then head to the complex of the Karnak temple and the fascinating Luxor Temple.

Afternoon flight to Cairo for final departure.
