Day 1: Arrive Cairo / Check-in

Our tour guide will meet and greet you at the Cairo International Airport in Egypt. After that, we will drive you in a climate-controlled car to your accommodation in Cairo.

Day 2: Pyramids, Mamphis, Sakkara

On the second day, following breakfast, your tour guide will take you to the first destination on your itinerary: the Necropolis of Giza. You will learn everything there is to know about ancient Egypt. I am aware Egypt Easter tours will begin with a visit to the Giza Pyramids, which comprise the Valley Temple, the Great Sphinx, and the three Great Pyramids. After that, we're going to the Memphis area.

We will have the opportunity to explore the contemporary Mit-Rahina neighborhood and tour Memphis' outdoor museum. The Alabaster Sphinx of Memphis, among other antiquities and sarcophagi, have been found at Mit-Rahina village, which presently stands on the site of Memphis. We're going to eat lunch at a nearby restaurant before we leave.

You will visit the Necropolis of Giza area. You will learn everything there is to know about ancient Egypt. After your visit to the Sakkara Pyramid, our tour guide will return you to your accommodation.

Day 3: Cairo to Sinai

Our representative will meet you at your Cairo accommodation to start your incredible Sinai Hiking Tours. After arriving in Sinai early in the morning and traveling for about five hours, we will check into the eco loge el karm Bedouin camp before beginning the hiking expedition. Check your luggage an hour after you've rested before starting your Egypt desert Safari tours.

Wadi Al Fara will be our first destination. This hike is notable for its steep ascent and swift descent. There's an accessible off-road drive of three kilometers. The Jabal Shayeb Al Banat mountain range in eastern Egypt's desert is the next destination.

The sides of the mountain are covered in broad stretches of volcanic rock and several deep canyons. Numerous tourism activities are available on this mountain, such as rock climbing, hiking trails, and camping, then make travel arrangements to see Wadi el Nogra.

Transport you to El Karm, your eco-camp.

Day 4: Sinai day treks

You'll be taken to Wadi Tala after preparing for breakfast in camp and sipping bedouin tea. Stick to the path ahead to get back to <u>St. Katherine</u>. Straight ahead, through a small opening in a stone retaining wall, the shorter path connects to Wadi Itlah. From this viewpoint, it is easy to see the thin curtains of water that emerge from the rock face after a shower, turning it white and creating a V-

shaped depression.

Next, we will take you to a Bedouin community and a sheik's tomb situated in this area of the high <u>Sinai mountains</u>. This is a popular hiking destination because the routes that connect St. Katherine and this area offer a variety of mountain vistas.

Then take you back to your tent so you can relax and have lunch there.

Day 5: Sinai to Cairo

We'll transport you back to Cairo so you may check into a hotel and spend the night there after breakfast at the camp.

Day 6: Egyptian Museum, Old Cairo

After breakfast, your tour guide will take you to <u>Tahrir Square</u> in Cairo so you can visit the Egyptian Museum. We'll take a leisurely stroll through the numerous halls of the museum to view the treasures housed within.

We will have a quick meal at a nearby restaurant before heading to <u>Old Cairo</u> from the city center. Our investigation into Islam will begin at <u>the Mamluk Mosque</u>, Sultan Hassan's Madrasa, and the mosque of <u>Ibn Tulun</u>, which is the oldest mosque still standing in Africa.

You will then be taken to Coptic Cairo. Emperor Trajan's Roman fortress of Babylon is the first stop on your tour of Cairo. It's situated in a neighborhood of Coptic people. Look at the Hanging Church, constructed atop the remains of the castle.

We will also take you to two important Coptic landmarks in Cairo that are close to the Holy Family Tomb: the Ben Ezra Synagogue and the Abu Serga Church. Find out more about Coptic Cairo from your guide.

Then drive you back to your hotel.

Day 7: Final Departure

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel on the last day of your seven-day tour to Cairo and the Sinai, then prepare to check out. Your tour guide from Cairo Top Tours will come get you so you can take the plane back to Cairo International Airport and return home.
