Itinerary

Day 1: Arrive Cairo, Egypt

When you arrive at <u>Cairo International Airport</u>, a representative from Cairo Top Tours will be there to greet you. He will provide you with air-conditioned transportation to your hotel in Cairo, assist you with all check-in procedures, and go over your Egypt itinerary. Confirm all pick-up times for your tour package and any additional activities you want to schedule in your 12-day itinerary.

Overnight and get ready for your next morning trip to the Pyramids of Egypt.

Day 2: Pyramids and Sphinx Excursion

On the second day, enjoy your tasty breakfast in the hotel, and you will meet your Egyptologist guide in the hotel lobby to start your adventure during the Giza Pyramids tour, which were built during the Fourth Dynasty of the Old Kingdom in ancient Egypt, and see the Sphinx too, which was thought to be built for King Chephren, the owner of the middle pyramid.

You will be surprised during your <u>tour of the Giza Pyramids</u> as you observe the greatest of the seven wonders of the world that had been built before the century by thousands of years to memorize the names of the great Pharaohs <u>Cheops</u>, Chephren, and Mycerinus.

Enjoy your lunch in a tremendous local restaurant and overnight in your hotel in Cairo.

Day 3: Alexandria Trip

We will proceed with our <u>tours in Egypt</u> by a comfortable air-conditioned vehicle for about 2 hours after you enjoy your breakfast, starting to spend your day tour to Alexandria from Cairo on the

Mediterranean, where <u>Alexander the Great</u> built the city of Alexandria in 332 BC and gave it its name. You will visit Greco-Roman sites like the <u>Catacombs of Kom El</u> Shoqafa, , its styles, and its decorations permit us to deduce that its construction was created in numerous periods, between the first, 2nd, and third centuries A.D.

Then, you will visit the ruins of the Roman temple complex, known as Pompey's pillar, and the Citadel of Qaitbay, the huge defensive fortification constructed in the 15th century, on the base where the famous lighthouse Pharos (one of the seven man-made wonders of the world) used to be standing, visit the modern <u>Bibliotheca of Alexandria</u>, which is one of the most substantial cultural centers all over Egypt, and have gourmet fresh seafood at a very good quality restaurant, then move to your hotel in Alexandria for overnight.

Day 4: Alexandria to Cairo - Egyptian Museum - Train to Aswan

Continue your enjoyable Cairo day tours after finishing your daily breakfast at the hotel. We will take you to the impressive <u>Egyptian Museum</u> in the heart of Cairo, which houses the world's largest and most comprehensive collection of Egyptian artifacts as well as the only royal treasure to have been discovered in good condition—the treasures of the golden pharaoh Tutankhamen.

Prior to being transferred to the train station to board the sleeping train bound for Aswan, a delectable lunch will be served at a reputable neighborhood restaurant.

Day 5: Arrive Aswan - Aswan Excursions

You will have breakfast on the train before arriving in Aswan! One of Egypt's most attractive cities, where you can learn about the proud <u>history of Egypt</u> and get a new perspective on the Nile River. We'll have a great time today seeing the most beautiful sites with Aswan Day Tours.

Visit the Aswan <u>High Dam</u>, which was constructed in 1960 to protect Egypt from yearly floods, followed by a visit to <u>the Philae Temple</u> and its amazing stones and carvings, which have been preserved for thousands of years and tell us about how great and advanced our ancestors were.

After that, you will be moved out to your hotel in Aswan for check-in and overnight.

Day 6: Abu Simbel Temples

After breakfast, you will have a memorable experience visiting Abu Simbel Temples, that great temple

was dedicated to the protective gods of ancient Egypt. Amun of Thebes (Luxor nowadays), <u>Ptah</u> of Memphis (the capital of Egypt during the <u>old kingdom</u>), and Ra.

The twin temples, built during the reign of <u>Ramses II</u>, were carved out of the mountainside in the 13th century B.C. and during <u>the19th dynasty</u>. They are monuments to the king and his Queen <u>Nefertari</u>, and to honor his triumph at the Battle of Kadesh, their huge external rock relief figures have become iconic.

After this exciting trip, you will be transferred back to your hotel in Aswan and stay overnight.

Day 7: Aswan to Luxor - Luxor Temple

Welcome to Luxor, the world's largest outdoor museum! Enjoy a fantastic breakfast at your Aswan hotel before being transferred to Luxor for one of the city's famous day trips. Luxor is a magnificent ancient Egyptian temple that was begun by King Amenhotep III in the 18th Dynasty (New Kingdom) and finished by Ramses II in the 19th Dynasty. It is located on the east bank of the Nile River.

After that, you will be transferred to your hotel in Luxor for check-in and overnight.

Day 8: Karnak Temple - Luxor West Bank - Transfer to Hurghada by Land

Eat breakfast at your Luxor hotel before meeting your personal driver and professional guide to pick up our Egypt travel packages and visit the magnificent <u>Karnak temples</u>, which are the best representation of Egypt's imperial majesty.

The god <u>Amon</u>, his famous goddess wife <u>Mut</u>, and their son Khonsu are honored in this temple. Many kings built it from the start of the Middle Kingdom to the Graeco-Roman Kingdom.

Before traveling to <u>Hurghada</u> by land and spending the night in a Hurghada hotel, you will also tour the West Bank of the Nile's historical sites, including the Valley of the Kings, the Colossi of Memnon, <u>Hatshepsut Temple</u> in Deir Al-Bahari, and the West Bank Monuments.

Day 9: Submarine Excursion in Hurghada

Enjoy your delicious breakfast before beginning your fantastic <u>Hurghada</u> day tours with our two-hour underwater excursion on board Sindbad Submarine in Hurghada.
