<u>Itinerary</u>

Day 1- Arrival

You will be met and assisted at <u>the Cairo International Airport</u> by the tour guide from Cairo Top Tours. After that, you'll meet your tour guide, who can speak English, before going to your hotel to check in and spend the night.

Day 2 - cairo day tour to pyramids

After breakfast, your tour guide will pick you up and take you in a plush, air-conditioned car to the Saggara <u>Necropolis' Noble Tombs</u>, where you can visit the tombs of Irukaptah and King Sekhemkhet.

Keep going to <u>Memphis Necropolis</u> (Mn Nefer), the first capital of Egypt's Old Kingdom, to visit the Mit Rahina open-air museum and see the famous Alabaster Sphinx, which was carved from a single large stone block, as well as the enormous sculptures of Ramses II.

While the Bent Pyramid is the most intact of the pyramids, the Red Pyramid is renowned for being the first precisely shaped pyramid in human history. Your private driver and Egyptologist will accompany you as you visit Dahshur, one of the most fascinating ancient Egyptian archaeological sites, which is a separate section of the Giza Necropolis.

Your tour guide will assist you in taking challenging professional photos for the best Egypt Tours memories during your Cairo Day Tours, which also include a delicious lunch at an excellent neighborhood restaurant.

Return you to your hotel so you can spend the night there.

Day 3: Old Cairo Tour

Once you've checked into the hotel, our guide will pick you up. The Saladin Stronghold of Cairo, a former Islamic citadel, is a good place to start. Mokattam hill, located close to Cairo's center, was once renowned for its cool breeze and breathtaking cityscapes. Take a break for lunch before visiting the Al-Rifa'i Mosque, which is close to Cairo Castle. The structure, which was constructed in Sultan Hassan in 1361 and is situated across from the Mosque-Madrassa, is thought to be a complement to the earlier one.

The Sultan Hassan Mosque-Madrassa is a sizable mosque and madrassa that was constructed in Cairo's Old City. When the mosque was first built, it was praised for its astounding size and cutting-edge architectural features. Al-Maqrizi claimed that the mosque was home to numerous "wonders of construction" and that its construction had been ordered by an-Nasir Hasan, a sultan with a brief and unremarkable history.

Bring you back to your hotel so you can unwind there.

Day 4: Baharyia oasis tour

Utilize our safari tour to <u>the Bahariya Oasis</u> and the White Desert by 4*4 to start your breathtaking <u>White Desert</u> Egypt excursion from your lodging. Including a short break, the journey from Cairo to the Bahariya Oasis takes about four hours.

We will take you to the Bahriya Oasis, which is about 420 kilometers from Cairo, where you can see the Valley of <u>Golden Mummies</u> and the Temple of Alexander the Great, who conquered Persia and ruled Egypt in 332 B.C. <u>The Temple of Ein Muftella</u>, one of the most important structures in <u>Egyptian history</u>, the Tombs of the Nobles who ruled the region during the 26th dynasty.

After lunch at a renowned restaurant where you can sample the regional cuisine made with organic ingredients, we'll travel to the hotel so you can spend the afternoon at leisure relaxing in the nearby hot spring.

In the late afternoon, we will pick you up once more and drive you up the Black Mountain in the land rover so you can explore the ruins of "the English House" and enjoy the expansive views of the oasis as dusk falls. the nighttime of Bahariya.

Day 5 : the withe desert tour

After breakfast, we'll travel to the White Desert, which is a part of the Farafra Oasis. In order to see the Black Desert, which is comprised of a number of Black formations and mountains that are heavily covered in ancient volcanic rocks, we will stop along the route for a rest stop. The final village of Bahariya to the south is the Valley of El Haize, which we'll pass through next. You can take a hot spring bath right here if you'd like.

We'll then drive you to the magnificent <u>Valley of Agabat</u> where you can practice sandboarding and see the quartz crystal in the Crystal Mountains. Last but not least, you'll camp out in the White Desert for the night and enjoy a breathtaking sunset as your guides make your delicious lunch.

Day 6: back cairo

After a hearty breakfast, you'll travel to the White Desert to discover the hot springs and take in the magnificent white limestone formations that have been sculpted here over many centuries by the yearly sandstorms that pass through this area. The Mushroom and the Rabbit are two of the many local names for these formations.

You'll switch to a more comfortable vehicle at Bahariya Oasis and take Bahariya back to your Cairo hotel.

Day 7: Departure
