Day 1 : Cairo overnight

When you arrive at <u>Cairo International Airport</u> on the first day of your wheelchair tour from Cairo to Luxor, which lasts 4 days, you will be greeted by your knowledgeable tour guide. that will take you to a five-star hotel in the heart of Cairo, putting you in the neighborhood and giving you a fantastic view. On the first day of the trip, you can relax in your room and make plans for the next day's travel.

Day 2: tour in Cairo attractions

When the second day's sunrise arrives, have breakfast at the hotel, then meet your individual tour guide to be taken to the first destination, which is <u>The Giza pyramids</u> and sphinx. One of the seven wonders of the world, with its pyramidal shape and numerous enormous bricks that, up until this point, no one is certain how they were constructed, and to protect them, the enormous <u>sphinx</u> is lying down in front of them.

After that, wheels will transport you to a restaurant for lunch. then proceed to the following location, which is <u>the Egyptian Museum</u>. To view the Egyptian Museum's real beauty collection, which includes artifacts from throughout Egyptian history besides the pharaohs. The shopping tour will be free after that. Then set up yourself to go back to the hotel by the A/C wheels for an overnight stay.

Note: You can choose to have if you prefer different locations. the tour of the Egyptian museum, the Giza pyramids, the Sphinx, or <u>the old Cairo</u> and Khan el Khalili bazaar.

Day 3: Luxor attractions.

On the third day of the four-day wheelchair tour from Cairo to Luxor, after enjoying a delicious breakfast at the hotel, arrange for your luggage to be transported from the hotel by air conditioned coach to the Cairo airport. Once you arrive at the Luxor international airport, you can begin your tour of the city's sights by visiting the Karnak Temple. Due to its splendor, the temple increased state tourism and is now one of the most well-known tourist destinations worldwide. There are three minor components, but they are equally as crucial as the main component.

You will go to the Luxor Temple. The ancient kings decided to construct an eternal temple to last forever, and King Amonhotep took the first step in doing so. The Hatshepsut temple is our final stop. The temple is made out of local limestone to commemorate the achievements of <u>Queen Hatshepsut</u> of the <u>18th Dynasty</u> of the <u>new kingdom</u> and also as a funerary temple and sanctuary for <u>Amun Ra</u> in which the divine birth story is mentioned.

Have your lunch at one of Luxor's restaurants, then get ready to back to your hotel again by private car. to have an overnight comfortable sleep.

Day 4: the last day

Prepare for the final day of the 4-day wheelchair tour from Cairo to Luxor, and don't forget to return after we take you to the airport so you can fly all the way back to Cairo.
