You will have the chance to explore the Bibliotheca Alexandrina, also known as the Alexandria Library, which was one of the largest and most significant libraries in the ancient world.

Next, your journey will take you to the Citadel of Qaitbay, a fortress built in the 15th century by Mamluk sultan Al-Ashraf Sayf al-Din Qaitbay on the site where the Lighthouse of Alexandria, one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World, once stood. Day 01: arrival in Alexandria

Your journey begins at [Alexandria International Airport](#), where a representative will greet you with a sign bearing your name and take you to your hotel. Once at your hotel, your Egyptologist guide will accompany you on your four-day wheelchair-accessible tour of Alexandria to Cairo, reviewing the itinerary of your wheelchair-accessible tours in Egypt to ensure everything is proceeding as planned.

Day 2: visit to Pompey's Pillar, the Citadel of Qaitbay, and The Alexandria Library

Our first stop for the day will be [Pompey's Pillar](#), the world's tallest memorial monument, which you will reach after enjoying your breakfast with your tour guide. Explore the ruins there; a sphinx and several other ancient structures can be found in the vicinity of Pompey's Pillar. Wandering through the ruins, visitors can picture life in prehistoric Alexandria.

Additionally, you can take pictures; there are many opportunities to capture Pompey's Pillar and the surrounding ruins on camera. Photographers can capture wide-angle views of the surroundings or up-close views of the detailed carvings on the column.

Following that, we'll take you to [The Citadel of Qaitbey](#), which is regarded as one of the most significant defensive fortresses. There, you can discover more about the history of the citadel by visiting the museum's numerous exhibits, which feature artifacts and weaponry from the fortress. Additionally, you can ascend to the citadel's summit to enjoy the breath-taking vistas.

Then proceed with our journey to [Bibliotheca Alexandrina](#), one of the biggest and most significant libraries on Earth, where you can explore the collection. See the planetarium, which presents a variety of astronomy and space science-related programs and exhibits. We'll take you to lunch at a seafood restaurant at the end of the day.

Day 3: Visit to the Giza Pyramids and the Egyptian Museum

After breakfast, check out of the hotel and our personal driver and licensed tour guide will take you to Cairo. Traveling 216 square kilometers (depending on the condition of the roads) from Cairo to Alexandria could take up to 2.5 hours.

We'll take you to see the three [pyramids at the Giza Pyramids](#), where you can view the Pyramid of [Mycerinus](#), which served as the hire of the Egyptian throne during the same 4th dynasty, the Pyramid of [Chephren](#), which is somewhat smaller in size but not less prominent, and the Great Pyramid of Cheops, which was built from over 3 million stone blocks and is considered an engineering marvel.

Following that, you will go to [the Egyptian Museum](#), where you can view the King Tutankhamun collection, which includes his sarcophagus and other artifacts from his tomb, as well as peruse the exhibits. View these magnificent artifacts and discover more about the life and legacy of this well-known pharaoh.

Following a delectable lunch at a fine dining establishment, we will transport you back to Alexandria.
