Itinerary

Day 1: Cairo - Siwa

Before beginning his journey to <u>Siwa</u>, the traveler will first meet his tour guide. Then, you'll be driven to Siwa, which is about 600 kilometers northwest of Cairo, the Egyptian capital, in the most luxurious air-conditioned minivan. On the way to our lunch stop at a nearby restaurant, we pass Marsa Matruoh, which has one of Egypt's most picturesque beaches.

To get ready for the breathtaking views you want to see the next day, get to Siwa, check in, and stay the night.

Day 2 : Siwa tour

After breakfast, we head to the Cleopatra Bath, the region's most well-known natural spring of water, to start our tour of Siwa. We could bathe in this stunning natural bath right now. There is no connection between the two and no justification for the name Queen Cleopatra given to this water spring. The temple of the Oracle of Amun, the most famous and important building in Siwa, will be the day's second stop. This temple housed one of the most well-known oracles in antiquity. In 331 BC, Alexander the Great visited this temple to be acknowledged as the King of Egypt.

We go to the "mountain of the dead," or Gabal Mawta as the locals call it in Arabic, where numerous rock-cut tombs have been discovered, dating from the Greco-Roman to the 26th Pharaonic dynasty. Only two of the notable tombs found there are the priest's tomb of Mesu-Isis from the 26th dynasty and Si-Amun's tomb from the third century BC.

Spend the evening at Siwa's hotel relaxing.

Day 3: Siwa tour

After a hearty breakfast, we set out for a journey to the Great Sand Sea in Egypt's Western Desert, which is situated in the biggest desert on the continent. Enjoy the splendor of one of Egypt's most iconic locations, the Sahara's majesty, and the never-ending sand dunes.

After passing <u>Dakrour Mountain</u>, we will now indulge in sandboarding, which allows us to enjoy the thrill of sliding down sand dunes as opposed to snow. After a day of skiing, you should relax at <u>the Bir Wahid</u> hot spring.

Spend the night in Siwa's hotel.

Day 4: Siwa / Cairo

After a sumptuous breakfast, we check out of the hotel and take a private, air-conditioned minivan to Cairo. In Cairo, check into your hotel, unwind, and stay the night.

Day 5: Giza Pyramids Tour, Egyption museum

Your trip will begin with a straightforward hotel pickup, and when you arrive, your guide will be waiting to welcome you. Now comes the fun part. Go back in time to the time of the Ancient Egyptians to see the fabled pyramids of Cheops, Chephren, and Mykerinus. Explore the ancient pharaohs' tombs and get up close to the Valley Temple and the Great Sphinx.

Experience what it was like to be an Egyptian in the ancient world by riding a camel through the desert. Without a doubt, this is a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity! Visit all of Cairo's lesser-known but significant <u>regional attractions</u> by taking a historical tour. Experience the expansive views of <u>the Pyramids</u> and the Sphinx, eat some optional Cairo fare, and visit the Egyptian Museum to see the priceless artifacts of the nation.
