Day 1: Embarkation - Aswan Tour

Our tour guide will meet you at the airport and take you on your way to the 5-star MS Movenpick Royal Lily Nile Cruise before lunch so you may take one of the largest Aswan day excursions. Start Egypt day trips, especially Aswan excursions, by touring the magnificent <u>High Dam</u>, which was constructed in the 1960s to protect the nation from Nile floods and provide Egypt with electricity.

As part of your Aswan excursions, you'll also travel on the Nile in a speedboat and see the lovely Philae Temple, which was constructed for the veneration of Goddess Isis, the goddess of magic in ancient Egyptian religion.

You can eat lunch on the Aswan to Luxor Nile Cruise boat, enjoy a leisurely afternoon tea while admiring the landscape of the Aswan Nile River, have dinner served to you there, and stay the night there after the performance.

Day 2: Kom Ombo and Edfu Temples

Breakfast is served on board the Nile cruise ship as it sails to the ancient Egyptian temples of Kom Ombo temple and Edfu, where the gods Sobek and Haroeris shared a temple. Before touring Edfu Temple, one of the biggest temples in Upper Egypt that was created for the God of the sky, God Horus, who was known as a falcon, sail to Edfu and have an open-buffet lunch on the boat. As the cruise ship makes its way to Esna and guests are taking part in the Egyptian Galabeya Party, dinner is served on board. Esna overnight

Day 3: Luxor East Bank Tours

Enjoy your breakfast on board the ship as you travel to Luxor via the Esna Lock and take in the breathtaking sights of the Nile River. Lunch and afternoon tea will then be served. The <u>Luxor Temple</u>, which was constructed between 1400 and 1000 BC by the pharaohs Amenhotep III and Ramses II, will now be the first stop on your Luxor day trips.

Continue your <u>Luxor East Bank Tours</u> with the magnificent <u>Karnak Temple</u>, which also features a large sacred lake, numerous smaller temples, chapels, and the main temple of Amun. <u>Queen Hatshepsut</u>, Seti I, <u>Ramses II</u>, and Ramses III were the most well-known pharaohs to be involved in its construction. Dinner and a belly dance performance were included with the Luxor Nile cruise. Afternoon in Luxor

Day 4: Luxor West Bank Tours - Disembarkation

You will be joined by your knowledgeable guide as you check out and have breakfast on the Nile cruise ship after beginning your <u>Luxor West Bank Tours</u>. Visit the <u>Valley of the Kings in Luxor</u>, Egypt's largest necropolis, where more than 60 rock-cut tombs once belonged to pharaohs of the New Kingdom are now known to exist. Continue your Luxor excursions to view the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut. This extraordinary monument can awe its guests for the duration of the customary Luxor Sightseeing tours. It was excavated on the sheer limestone cliffs that rise above the desert in the valley of <u>Deir el-Bahari cache</u>.

Finally, transfer to the rail or airport in Luxor.
