#### **Itinerary**

### Day 1: Arrival to Luxor - Embarkation - Luxor East Bank

At the Luxor Airport or Train Station, our representative will greet and assist you. They will then drive you to your Egypt Nile River Cruise for lunch and check-in. Start your Luxor day tours by seeing the <a href="Karnak">Karnak</a>
Temple, which were constructed between 2200 and 360 B.C. and are devoted to <a href="Amun Re">Amun Re</a>, the father of the Egyptian gods. Then, continue your Luxor East Bank Tours to the well-known <a href="Luxor Temple">Luxor Temple</a>, which was constructed during the <a href="New Kingdom">New Kingdom</a> and is dedicated to the Theban triad. The obelisk in Concorde Square in Paris was given as a gift by <a href="Mohamed Ali">Mohamed Ali</a> in 1836 and was originally from this temple, where there were two of them flanking the entrance. Following your visit to Luxor, your private tour guide will bring you back to the cruise ship where you may have your lunch and afternoon tea before seeing the belly-dancing show. Dinner and an overnight stay in Luxor are included in your Luxor to Aswan Nile Cruise.

#### Day 2: Luxor West Bank Tours

Your guide will join you on the West Bank tours in Luxor to explore the colorful tombs of the Pharaohs inside the Valley of the Kings in Luxor after you have breakfast on the cruise ship. King Thutmose I, a pharaoh of the 18th dynasty, was the first to be interred at the royal necropolis. The enormous statues, known as the Colossi of Memnon, were created for King Amenhotep III, the father of one of ancient Egypt's most significant monarchs, King Amenhotep IV, often known as Akhenaten, rebelled against the established Amun cult, which infuriated the priests. You will eventually continue your Luxor sightseeing excursions in Deir Al-Madina and at the Temple of Madinet Habu, which was constructed by the New Kingdom pharaohs. The Nile cruise ship will sail to the town of Esna, where lunch will be served before afternoon tea and the Captain's Welcome Cocktail Party. The Nile cruise ship will serve dinner before stopping for the night in Esna.

### Day 3: Edfu and Kom Ombo Temples

After breakfast, your licensed Egyptologist will take you to see the famed <u>Edfu</u> Temple, which was erected to serve the god Horus. From there, you'll sail to Kom Ombo. Before departing for <u>Kom Ombo temple</u> to visit the Ptolemaic architectural style temple, lunch and afternoon tea will be served on the cruise ship. The visit to this temple is one of the most beautiful because you will see some exceptionally well-preserved crocodile mummies in the chapel of <u>Goddess Hator</u>. You will then have your open-buffet dinner served on the cruise ship and spend the night in Kom Ombo.

### Day 4: Aswan Nile Cruise Tours

After breakfast on the cruise ship in Aswan, you will be accompanied by our guide on your <u>Egypt Day trips</u> to see the <u>High Dam</u>, the <u>Unfished Obelisk</u> of Queen Hatshepsut inside the Granite Quarries, and continue your Aswan excursions to the Temple of Philae, which was formerly built near the open first Cataract of the Nile River in Up. Before the High Dam was built, the annual flooding of the Nile during summer had continued to drown largely many areas in Enjoy the Nubian Folkloric Show while dining in style on the cruise ship.
