Itinerary

Day 1: Luxor East Bank Tours

Your names will be on a signboard that our representative is holding when he picks you up from the airport and helps you find him. After that, you'll board your Egypt Nile River Cruise and begin your Egypt day trips with your knowledgeable tour guide to enjoy Luxor East Bank Tours; Luxor is located 700 kilometers south of Cairo. The city's population of nearly 500,000 primarily relies on agriculture and tourism. Visit the magnificent Karnak Temple, the largest temple in Egypt. It was constructed and expanded over the course of 2000 years from a small shrine in the Middle Kingdom to a massive Temple that covers a sizable area to worship Amun-Re, the Lord of All Gods of ancient Egypt. Your transfer will then take you to the magnificent Luxor Temple, which is situated in the city that bears his name and was found in 1884 on the East Bank of the Nile in Luxor.

Spend the night on board before continuing your Egypt tours the next day. Breakfast and lunch

Day 2: Luxor West Bank Tours

You will enjoy your breakfast on board your Egypt Nile River Cruise today before beginning your Luxor day tours, but today to the west bank of Luxor tours, where you will get to see one of the most fascinating sites in the world, the Valley of the Kings, where the vast majority of Egypt's kings and rulers during the New Kingdom rest in peace. After that, you will see the magnificent temple of Queen Hatshepsut during Luxor excursions, known as El-Deir El-Bahari Temple She was strong considering that she oversaw an empire that extended to Mesopotamia and commanded military campaigns outside of Egypt. The enormous statues of King Amenhotep III, also known as the Colossi of Memnon, are now visible where a huge temple that was constructed under his rule formerly stood. Enjoy the trip to Edfu as you cruise the Nile.

Day 3: Edfu and Kom Ombo Temples

The majestic Temple of <u>Edfu</u>, which is thought to be the center of worship for the falcon-god Horus, who was revered as the king of heaven, will be your first stop on the tour to Edfu, which will begin at 8:00 AM with the assistance of our Egyptologist guide. After finishing the tour at 10:30 AM, you'll get back on the boat and head to Kom Ombo.

Visit the temples in <u>Kom Ombo temple</u> at 17:00, then take a boat to Aswan. Aswan is notable for being the starting point for trips to the Temple of Abu Simbel, despite not having as many attractions as Luxor.

Spend the night on the Aswan cruise ship. Breakfast, lunch, and dinner

Day 4: Aswan Excursions

After breakfast, begin your Aswan day tours by visiting the High Dam, which allowed for the

development of previously inundated areas when the Nile flooded Egypt each year, the Unfinished Obelisk, which was allegedly carved by <u>Queen Hatshepsut</u> during the new kingdom but was not completed because of Hatshepsut's passing and then continues your Aswan excursions to the <u>Temple of Philae</u>, which was constructed in honor of the <u>Goddess Isis</u> in the Island of Agilika.

Day 5: Disembarkation

You will eat breakfast on the final day of your Egypt Nile boat excursions before leaving your Al Kahila Nile boat from Luxor to Aswan. the transport to any Aswan drop-off location that was desired. Dining: Breakfast
