Day 1: Arrival at Luxor - Check-In

Our tour leader in Luxor will meet you in the morning and transfer you in a private air-conditioned vehicle to start your [Egypt day trips](#) on Sonesta St. George Nile River Cruise. After lunch, you will accompany our tour guide for a visit to the Karnak Temple, which is an ancient temple built over a thousand years ago. We will then visit [Luxor Temple](#), which was created in the 14th century BC by Ramses II, Queen Hatshepsut, and other rulers and was finished many years afterward. You will be taken on your Nile cruise for rest. The evening is free to rest on board or you can book our optional tour to watch the sound and light that displays at [Karnak Temple](#), which is one of Egypt's most amazing performances. We will then return to our Nile cruise for the night.

Meals: Lunch and dinner.

Day 2: West Bank Tour

A nice breakfast will be served on board. Then we'll visit the [Valley of the Kings](#), which is one of Egypt's wealthiest and most fascinating ancient tombs. The New Kingdom's rulers were buried here. Our second stop on the day will be to the temple of Deir El Bahari, which was built by [Queen Hatshepsut](#) during the 18th Dynasty. On the way back to the boat, we will stop in front of the [Colossi of Memnon](#), which are the only remnants of King Amenhotep III's massive burial complex. Following that, we will take you back to your Nile cruise.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner.

Day 3: Sightseeing Tour to Edfu and Kom Ombo Temples

Before going to Edfu and Kom Ombo Temples, a delicious breakfast will be served on board. Our Nile cruise ship will land at [Edfu](#), where we will visit the Temple of Horus, which was built by the Ptolemies in the 3rd century BC for the worship of Horus, the father's avenging deity. We will return to our Nile cruise ship for lunch, rest, and refreshments after our exciting trip. You will visit The [Kom Ombo Temple](#), which was erected during the Ptolemaic period and completed in Roman times. Following that, you will be returned to your Nile cruise ship to rest and unwind. The crew will perform a folklore show in the evening.

Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner.

Day 4: Aswan Sightseeing Tour

Breakfast will be served on the ship. Following that, you will get ready to meet your tour guide for Aswan Tours. Our first stop of the day will be at the [High Dam](#), which was erected by [Gamal Abdel Nasser](#), the former Egyptian president, to hold back water and then generate a great amount of electricity. After that, we'll take a speedboat to Philae Temple, which was built in the 3rd century BC and was the center of worship for the goddess Isis in Greco-Roman times. Our next stop will be an [unfinished obelisk](#), which was uncovered in a granite quarry in Aswan's southern district. We will return to our Nile cruise ship for a

delicious lunch. In the evening, you can either relax on board or go on an optional trip to [Philae Temple](#) to see the sound and light show and learn more about the temple and the monarchs who left their treasures there.

After that, we'll return to our Nile cruise for the evening.

Day 5: Disembarkation in Aswan

On the last day of your tour. Enjoy a goodbye breakfast on board before disembarking. One of our friendly tour guides will meet you and drive you to [Aswan Airport](#) or Train Station in a comfortable air-conditioned car to catch your flight to your next destination.
