Day 1: Arrival at Aswan

You will be transferred from Aswan airport to your lovely cruise ship for a three-night Nile cruise. After checking in, you will begin your full-day guided tour with a boat excursion to the [Philae Temple](#), which was built in honor of the goddess Isis.

The Aswan [High Dam](#), an engineering marvel that functions as a dike dam on the Nile and was built in the 1960s to safeguard Egypt from yearly flooding, will come next. After lunch, you will be sent back to the cruise ship, where you will be able to engage in cruise activities and dine in the evening.

You will spend the night on board in Aswan.

Meals: Lunch and dinner.

Day 2: Abu Simbel Temples

An early morning guided tour of the [Abu Simbel temples](#) will take place.

The Great Temple of Abu Simple was created by King Ramses II to be worshiped inside his temple, as well as by other gods like Rahorakhty, Ptah, [Osiris](#), and Amen Ra.

The boat will visit Kom Ombo and Edfu on its way back from Abu Simbel. [Kom Ombo temple](#), dedicated to the crocodile god Sobek, will be visited. Following this stop, you will set sail for [Edfu](#). You will be shown the Horus Temple, which is dedicated to Horus, the falcon-headed divinity. This pharaonic temple, which is still relatively new, has been properly kept and is thus rather magnificent.

Dinner will be served on board in the evening, and you will spend the night there.

(Breakfast, lunch, and dinner were included).

Day 3: Arrive to Luxor

The ship will travel through the city of Esna on its journey to [Luxor](#). Today, you can simply sit on the balcony and gaze out the window at the people on the river and its banks. You can attend the nighttime sound and light performance at the [Karnak temples](#) after landing in Luxor (extra fee).

Your final night at sea will be spent in Luxor.

Day 4: Luxor tour - Disembarkation

After breakfast, depart the cruise at 8:00 a.m. to begin your day of touring on Luxor's West Bank. You will first be taken to the Thebes Necropolis, often known as the [Valley of the Kings](#), on the West Bank of Luxor. This ancient necropolis is a must-see for travelers visiting Luxor. It consists of tombs buried in Thebes Mountain. Three tombs from various dynasties are visited. Your tour guide can assist you and recommend which tombs to see. After touring the tombs, you will be escorted to Queen Hatshepsut's temple. Then you'll be taken to view the [Colossi of Memnon](#), Egypt's two greatest ancient statues.

To complete your Nile trip, you will visit the temples of Karnak and Luxor on the east bank of Luxor. All other pharaonic structures pale in comparison to Karnak temple, which is simply one of Egypt's most gorgeous ancient monuments. Your tour guide will explain each location, and you will have free time to explore the ancient sites on your own.

Finally, we will transfer to [Luxor International Airport](#) to return home.
