Day 1: Arrival at Luxor - East Bank of Luxor tour

After that, your tour guide will take you to <u>Luxor Temple</u>, where you will see the entire performance while being surrounded by the pharaonic kings' secrets. The building is referred to as the <u>Kom Ombo Temple</u> Your Egyptologist will then take you to Kom Ombo.

After that, go on a sailing tour to <u>Edfu</u> for a delicious lunch. Have a delicious meal while watching the Jalabiya party. Whenever the cruise ship arrives in Luxor for the night, unwind in your lovely lodging.

Day 7: West Bank of Luxor Tour
