Day 1: Arrive at Luxor - Luxor East Bank Tours

On your arrival day, you will arrive in Luxor, which is home to many ancient Egyptian sites. After checking in to your accommodations, you can begin exploring Luxor's East Bank. The East Bank of Luxor is where you'll find the Temple of Karnak, one of the largest religious complexes in the world, dedicated to the worship of the god Amun. You can also visit the Luxor Temple, a magnificent temple dedicated to the [god Amun-Ra](#) and explore it.

Day 2: Luxor West Bank Tours - Sail to Edfu

In [Kom Ombo temple](#), you can visit the Temple of Kom Ombo, a unique double temple dedicated to both the crocodile god [Sobek](#) and the falcon god Horus.

Day 4: Aswan Sightseeing Tours

Upon arrival in Aswan, you'll have a full day to explore this picturesque city. Aswan is known for its stunning natural scenery and historical sites. Next, you can visit the [Philae Temple](#), an ancient temple dedicated to the goddess Isis, which was relocated to Gilkia Island after the construction of the Aswan High Dam.
