Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival at Aswan - Aswan Tour

Our tour guide will greet you at the Aswan airport and accompany you to the MS Tuya for your cruise. Upon departure, your lunch in <u>Egypt day trips</u> will be served on board. Then you'll go to the Aswan High Dam, which President <u>Gamal Abdel Nasser</u> erected in 1960 to safeguard Egypt from Nile floods while saving energy and electricity.

You will then cross the Nile to the famed <u>Philae Temple</u>, which was built during the Greco-Roman period and is devoted to the <u>goddess Isis</u> Finally, The <u>Unfinished Obelisk</u> of Queen Hatshepsut, which was erected of red granite and dedicated to the <u>god Amun Ra</u>, will appeal to you. After that, you'll return to your ship, and at night, you'll have free time to explore Aswan on your own.

Lunch and dinner are included.

Day 2: Kom Ombo - Edfu Temple

Breakfast will be provided on your Nile cruise. Our tour guide will next take you to one of Egypt's most stunning temples, the <u>Kom Ombo Temple</u>, which was devoted to the <u>gods Sobek</u> and Haroeris. After that, you'll return to your cruise and enjoy lunch while viewing the Nile scenery.

In the afternoon, you'll enjoy a chariot ride to <u>Edfu</u>'s Temple of Horus. You will then return to your cruise to recover and enjoy your lunch. In the evening, you will see an Egyptian folklore show on board.

Breakfast, lunch, and dinner are all included.

Day 3: Luxor West Bank Tour

Enjoy breakfast on the Nile before departing for Thebes and seeing Luxor's west bank, where you will visit the <u>Valley of the Kings</u>, the regal burial place of ancient pharaohs. Then you'll travel to Deir El Bahari to see <u>Queen Hatshepsut</u>'s Temple. The main architect Sennmut erected this temple on three elevated terraces and cut it totally into the mountain, making it one of the most beautiful in ancient Egypt.

Finally, you will view King Amenhotep III's <u>Colossi of Memnon</u> You will then return to the deck to relax and have your lunch. Enjoy your dinner and your evening.

Breakfast, lunch, and dinner are all included.

Day 4: Luxor East Bank Tour - Final Departure

After breakfast, you will be transported to Luxor's east bank to see the majestic and largest temples, The <u>Karnak Temple</u>, which is regarded as the most intricate building in the world, and then the <u>Luxor</u> <u>Temple</u> before departing for the Luxor International Airport.
