<u>Itinerary</u>

Day 1: Luxor East Bank tour

You will arrive at Luxor and our representative will meet and greet you at the Train Station or Airport and transfer you in a private air-conditioned vehicle to start your Egypt day tours in one of the most popular cities in Egypt. You will visit the greatest structure in the world, the Karnak temple complex. You will see The Luxor Temple, which was built by a ruler of the 12th dynasty and finished by the illustrious Pharaoh Ramses II. After your journey, you will be taken back to your ship to relax. The personnel will perform an Egyptian folklore show in the evening.

After having dinner, you'll spend the night in Luxor.

Day 2: Luxor West Bank Excursion

On a Nile cruise, breakfast is included. You will visit the Valley of the Monarchs, where you'll start your stunning journey to Thebes, the sacred area before going to Thebes. The <u>Valley of the Kings</u> is thought to be the royal burial site for Theban monarchs and rulers of ancient Egypt, as well as the final resting place of our pharaohs.

After that, you'll travel to Deir El Bahari to visit the <u>Queen Hatshepsut</u> temple. This temple is regarded as one of the most stunning examples of ancient Egyptian architecture since it was fully carved out of the mountain. You will also see <u>Colossi of Memnon</u>, which belonged to King Amenhotep III. After that, you'll head back to the ship for lunch.

Meals: Breakfast, lunch, and dinner.

Day 3: Edfu & Kom Ombo Temples

Breakfast is served on the cruise. Your tour guide will lead you on a mysterious adventure to the land of pharaohs. One of Egypt's most stunning and well-preserved monuments, the Temple of Horus in Edfu, will be the first stop in your program. Then, you'll be driven back to your ship. Lunch will be served on board throughout the journey to Kom Ombo. You will go to the Kom Ombo temple in the afternoon, which was formerly a place of worship for the two gods Sobek and Haroeris. Return to your ship, where you can enjoy lunch on the sun deck while taking in the unique atmosphere of the Nile on its banks, the civilization of ancient Egypt arose and grew. You will return to your ship after the excursion so that you can relax and refuel. Dinner will be served on board while traveling to Aswan. You will spend the night in Aswan.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner.

Day 4: Aswan Tour

Upon boarding your ship, breakfast will be provided. Your tour guide will be waiting for you to start your Aswan day tours, which will include a trip to the <u>High Dam</u>, which was constructed to protect Egypt from the Nile floods.

After that, you'll take a boat to <u>Agilika Island</u>, where you'll visit the temple of Philae, which was built in honor of the <u>goddess Isis</u> (the mother of the god Horus).

Finally, you will be transferred to the <u>Unfinished Obelisk</u>, which is a red granite structure that is dedicated to the <u>god Amun Re</u> and one of Aswan's most stunning structures. Once your day trip is over, you'll head back to your ship. There you will enjoy lunch and afternoon tea. You will spend the night on your cruise in Aswan.

Day 5: Disembarkation in Aswan

Our 4-day Iberotel Crown Emperor program will end today. After a sumptuous breakfast, a representative from Cairo Top Tours will assist you to disembark from the Nile cruise and transfer you to the <u>Aswan Airport</u> or Railway Station, where you will catch your flight or train.
