## Day 1: Arrival in Cairo

Upon arrival at [Cairo International Airport](#), a tour leader from Cairo Top Tours will be waiting for you, holding a sign with your name. You'll be taken to your hotel in Giza or Cairo in a new private vehicle for check-in and overnight stay. If you're interested in booking any additional trips in Cairo, you can speak to your tour consultant who will suggest some exciting things to do on the first day of your three-day Cairo short break.

During your first day, you can opt to attend the incredible sound and light show at the Giza pyramids or enjoy a charming two-hour Nile dinner cruise in Cairo with an oriental show and an open buffet of delicious Egyptian cuisine.

## Day 2: Giza Pyramids, Coptic and Islamic Cairo Tours

After a delicious breakfast at your hotel, meet your Egyptologist and begin your day trip to Egypt. Your first stop will be the famous Pyramids of Giza, one of the most famous and impressive monuments in the world. These ancient pyramids were built over 4,500 years ago as burial places for the pharaohs and their consorts and are among the oldest monuments in the world. The necropolis of Giza is considered a sacred site in the history of ancient Egypt and you will have the opportunity to visit the Great Pyramid of King Cheops, also known as Cheops in ancient hieroglyphics. Your guide will take you on a journey back in time and tell you about the ancient Egyptian religion and how it influenced the construction of the incredible monuments built in honor of the gods of ancient Egypt.

During your visit to the Pyramids of Giza, you will have the opportunity to enter the Valley Temple of Khafre, the successor of King Khafre, whose pyramid complex is the only complete one of all the pyramids in Egypt. You will also see the Great Sphinx, located within the complex and carved for the king himself in the mythical figure of a lion with the head of a man. In ancient Egyptian culture, this symbolized that the king possessed both authority and ferocity.

After visiting the Pyramids of Giza, the next stop on your tour of Coptic and Islamic Cairo is the Citadel of Saladin. This medieval fortress was built in the 12th century by the famous Sultan Saladin and is a must-see in Cairo.

At the end of the tour you will be transferred to the hotel.

## Day 3: Check-Out, Optional Tour to Saqqara and Memphis

After enjoying your daily buffet breakfast, it will be time to check out of your hotel and be transferred to Cairo Airport or another drop-off location. If you have enough time, you can book an incredible tour of the Saqqara Necropolis. Here, you'll have the opportunity to see the Step [Pyramid of Djoser](#), as well as the Tombs of the Nobles. Additionally, you can visit the ancient city of Memphis, where you'll see many statues of King Ramses II from the New Kingdom period, as well as the impressive alabaster sphinx of Memphis. This tour is an excellent way to end your visit to Cairo and see even more of the incredible history and culture of ancient Egypt.
