Itinerary

Day1- Tour To Pyramids Of Giza and the Egyptian museum

The primary destination of the tour is the Great <u>Pyramids of Giza</u>, including Cheops, Chephren, and Mykerinos. Upon arrival at your -Hotel, a tour guide will pick you up in a modern, air-conditioned car and take you to the Giza Pyramids. You will have the opportunity to see the Sphinx, a well-known protector of a large burial complex with the body of a lion and the head of King Chephren. Additionally, you will visit The Valley Temple, where King Chephren's remains were mummified by the priests. Please note that accessing any of the pyramids requires an additional ticket and is not included in the tour.

-Afterward, we will bring you to an entertaining show. <u>The Egyptian Museum</u>, one of the world's largest collections of ancient artifacts, is situated in Downtown Cairo, just north of Midan Tahrir. The massive, distinctive pink building houses not only the amazing treasures of Tutankhamun and other famous pharaohs, but also mummies, burial objects, jewelry, eating utensils, and toys crafted by anonymous Egyptians of the past. The museum is like a time machine that allows you to journey through history.

-Our next destination will be <u>Khan El-Khalili</u> in Old Cairo, established in the 14th century and historically significant as a hub of commercial and cultural activity. To help you navigate the Khan El-Khalili market and its environs, we have provided a map.

-Returning you ultimately to your Cairo lodging.

Day2- Desert and Bahariya Oasis

-This is a one-day itinerary that begins with a 6:00 AM pick-up from your Cairo lodging. The tour departs the city through nearby desert landscapes and heads to the stunning <u>Bahariya Oasis</u>, which was the primary agricultural hub of the Pharaonic Empire. With the assistance of your guide, explore the oasis and take in the expansive setting of shaded palm trees and natural springs. Enjoy lunch before heading to <u>The Black Desert</u> for a breathtaking view of the region's craggy, mountain-like domes that stand out against the surrounding sand.

-Next, visit the Agabat Valley, known for its spectacular white cliff walls and yellow limestone rocks. Then, head to Crystal Mountain, a rare structure composed entirely of calcite crystal that glistens and glows in the Egyptian sun. The White Desert, with its vast expanse of white sand, is the final stop. Climb a few sand dunes for breathtaking views that seem to go on forever.

-Finally, relax on the journey back to Cairo, arriving at your hotel around 11:00 PM.

Day 3

-Take the Egyptologist tour guide from Your Egypt Tours along for an interesting trip from Cairo to Alexandria.

-The second-largest city in Egypt, Alexandria, is well-known for its Roman ruins and has more of a Mediterranean than a Middle Eastern feel. You will receive a personalized tour of Alexandria from your Egyptologist tour guide while learning about the city. You choose how long to stay at each place you visit along the way. In 332 B.C., Alexander the Great established Alexandria as the nation's capital. Your first visit to this ancient city should take you to the catacombs of Kom ash-Shuqqafa, a Roman cemetery with a family tomb that exhibits the fusion of Egyptian and Roman art and architecture. Visit the tomb located beneath Caracalla Hall.

-Once you're back above ground, visit Pompey's Pillar, a 25-meter-tall granite monument built to honor Emperor Diocletian, who saved the city from a siege and fed the starving citizens. Your tour guide will also take you to <u>the Citadel of Qaitbay</u>, constructed in 1477 to safeguard the eastern side of the city and reflect the Roman influence. The significant lighthouse of Alexandria stood near the fort.

-After lunch (at an additional cost), you will visit the <u>Alexandria Library</u>, a breathtaking example of modern architecture designed by Norwegians and in contrast to the historic buildings found throughout Egypt. The library is one of the largest literary institutions globally, as it contains copies of every book ever written. Additionally, the library features several historical displays and a collection of priceless antiquarian books (available at an additional cost).

-Then drive you back to your Cairo hotel.

Day4- Final Departure

After having breakfast and checking out of your Cairo hotel, our tour guide will pick you up and accompany you to the <u>Cairo international airport</u> located approximately 15 miles (24 kilometers) northeast of downtown Cairo, Egypt.
