Itinerary

Day 1: Arrive Cairo, Egypt

When you arrive at <u>Cairo International Airport</u>, our representative will be there to greet you with a sign bearing your name and be available to help you with any procedures as you start your trip to Egypt. You will be driven to your hotel from the airport in a private, non-smoking, air-conditioned vehicle. As you receive a welcome drink at the hotel, our tour guide from Cairo Top Tours will help you check in without incident and go over the itinerary for your Egypt vacation packages with you to confirm the pick-up times for each tour.

Cairo's overnight stay.

Day 2: Giza Pyramids / Saqqara / Memphis

Join your professional tour guide after breakfast in the hotel lobby for an exciting day trip to Giza, Memphis, and <u>Saqqara</u> with our Cairo Day Tours. Your private guide and driver will take you to see the iconic Great Pyramid of Cheops, as well as the pyramids of Chephren and Mycerinus from the 4th dynasty of pharaohs in the old kingdom. You'll also visit the Great Sphinx and the <u>Valley Temple</u> of King Chephren. For a unique experience, you can take an optional 15-minute camel ride at Giza.

Next, you'll visit the Step Pyramid of <u>King Zoser</u>, the Djoser Pyramid, and the Teti Pyramid in Sakkara. You'll have the chance to explore the tombs of the nobles and see the ancient paintings on the walls and corridors. Enjoy a delicious lunch at a local restaurant before heading to Memphis, just 20 minutes away from Saqqara, to explore the open-air museum. Here, you'll see a rich collection of statues and artifacts from ancient Egypt, including the alabaster sphinx and the gigantic fallen statue of Ramses II.

After your tour, you'll be transferred back to your hotel for the night. This is an unforgettable way to experience the wonders of ancient Egypt.

Meals included are breakfast and lunch.

Day 3: Tour to The Egyptian Museum, Coptic and Islamic Cairo

Get ready for a day packed with fascinating historical sites on our Cairo Top Tours. Your Egyptologist guide will pick you up from your hotel and take you to the Egyptian Museum, one of the largest museums in the world. Here, you'll discover a vast collection of ancient antiquities and Coptic artifacts while your guide explains the highlights, including the treasures of King Tutankhamun - a collection of gold and jewelry discovered intact in his tomb after more than three thousand years.

Next, you'll visit the <u>Citadel of Saladin</u> and the Alabaster Mosque of Mohamed Ali, a unique example of

Ottoman architecture in Cairo. The Citadel served as the center of the Egyptian government from the time of Saladin until the reign of King Farouk in the first half of the past century.

After lunch at a high-quality restaurant, you'll head to <u>Coptic Cairo Tour</u> to explore the ancient Roman fortress of Babylon and marvel at The Hanging Church - one of the highlights of old Cairo. You'll also visit the church of St. Sergius, known as the Cavern Church, and Ben Ezra Synagogue, which according to tradition, was the site of the pharaoh's palace where Moses was found in the Nile.

Next, you'll explore the ruins of medieval Cairo in Islamic Cairo and see the ancient walls, mosques, madrasas, and gates of the city, which date back to the 10th century. Your walk will end with a cup of tea at Fishawy's, the oldest cafe in Khan El Khalili - Cairo's old bazaar.

Meals included are breakfast and lunch.

Day 4: Cairo to Luxor / East Bank of Luxor Tour

Your tour guide will accompany you to Cairo International Airport to catch your domestic flight to Luxor, the tourism capital of Egypt. Upon arrival, you'll board the Nile Cruise and begin your adventure exploring the eternal river and its fascinating monuments and history. After checking in and taking a break in your cabin, you'll enjoy a delicious lunch served on board.

Next, we'll embark on our <u>Luxor Day Tours</u> and start at the <u>Karnak temple</u> complex, a natural museum of ancient Egyptian art and a testament to the power and glory of a golden era. We'll then visit the <u>Temple of Luxor</u>, another impressive measure of the greatness of the New Kingdom Pharaohs. Afterward, you'll have some leisure time to relax on the Nile Cruise before enjoying a lovely dinner in the restaurant on board.

If you're interested, there's also an optional sound and light show at the <u>Karnak temple</u> that can be arranged.

Day 5: West Bank of Luxor/ Edfu

Start your day with a delicious breakfast before embarking on our <u>Luxor West Bank Tours</u>. You'll have the opportunity to enjoy the beautiful scenery of the Nile Valley during tea time on the upper deck of the cruiser. After the visit, we'll return to the cruise ship, which will sail towards Aswan while you enjoy your tea. Dinner will be served in the evening, and you can enjoy the entertainment and another comfortable night's rest on the Nile River.
