Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival at Cairo International Airport - Check-in

Our representative will meet you at the <u>Cairo International Airport</u> and take you to your hotel in Cairo in a private air-conditioned vehicle.

You will be given a welcome drink when you arrive at the hotel, and he will go over your 11 days of Egypt Easter Tours with you to make sure your pick-up times and schedule in the land of civilization are as planned. He will also help you with a quick check-in.

Cairo overnight stay.

Day 2: Pyramids and Cairo Tours

After breakfast at your hotel, your <u>Cairo Excursions</u> and day tours will begin. You'll start with a visit to the giant <u>Giza Pyramids</u> of King Khufu, Khafre, and Mycerinus, and the Great Sphinx - a powerful lion carved from Egyptian limestone bedrock during the reign of King Khafre.

You'll then enjoy lunch at a local Egyptian restaurant before continuing your tour to the Egyptian Museum, where you'll find a vast collection of ancient Egyptian antiquities. After that, you'll take a Coptic Cairo Tour, visiting the Hanging Church of the Holy Virgin Mary, the Church of Saint Sergius and Bachus, and the Synagogue of Ben Ezra.

Once your day tour is finished, you'll be transferred back to your hotel in Cairo for an overnight stay. Breakfast and lunch will be provided during the tour.

Day 3: White Desert Tour

Having breakfast there and touring the White Desert The layer of chalk and limestone that partially covers the landscape gave this desert its name. This is a relic from tens of millions of years ago when the area that is now dry was submerged in the sea. Near the Libyan desert, you can always find the remains of sea urchins, shells, and even coral reefs. The Bahariya Oasis is close to the Valley of El Haize in the Black Desert, an area of volcano-shaped mountains covered in a lot of small black stones. We will also see the majestic Valley of Agabat and the shining Crystal Mountain, Spend a camping night in the desert to take in the sunset and enjoy your

Day 4: Bahariya Oasis Tour

After breakfast today, we'll travel to the White Desert tour's most stunning white formations. Although you might assume that these sculpture-like formations, which include shapes like a rabbit, mushrooms, and other objects, were created artificially, they actually developed naturally. We'll also visit some hot springs. You will be driven overnight from Bahariya Oasis back to Cairo.

Day 5: Cairo to Aswan - Aswan Sightseeing Tours

After enjoying a delicious breakfast at your hotel, you'll be transferred to Cairo International Airport for a flight to Aswan. Upon arrival, you'll meet our representative from <u>Cairo Top Tours</u> and begin your Aswan tours, starting with a visit to <u>the Philae Temple</u>, This temple features unusual stones and engravings that have remained intact for thousands of years. You'll also see <u>the High Dam</u>, which was established in 1960 to protect Egypt from the annual tides.

After your tour, you'll be transported to your hotel in Aswan, where you'll check in and spend the night. It's worth mentioning that the Philae Temple has an interesting history - the Welle Temple was dedicated to the Egyptian goddess "Isis" and was originally located on Philae Island. However, during UNESCO's campaign in the 1960s to rescue sites flooded by the Nile during the construction of the Aswan High Dam, the elephant monuments were transferred to the nearby island of Angelica, 500 meters from the original island of Felle.

You'll be provided with breakfast and lunch during the tour.

Day 6: Edfu Temple - Overnight in Luxor

After breakfast, take a trip to the enormous <u>Edfu Temple</u>, which was constructed on the western bank of the Nile River to honor Horus, the falcon god. Before being driven to check into your Luxor hotel, your private guide will show you the temple's most noteworthy locations while you enjoy a fine lunch.

Day 7: Luxor Museum - Karnak Temple

Before visiting the fascinating <u>Luxor Museum</u>, which has two floors and exhibits artifacts discovered inside <u>Tutankhamen's tomb</u> and other New Kingdom statues discovered also in <u>Luxor Temple</u>, a local breakfast will be provided at the hotel. After that, you will have the most amazing tour in Luxor to see Luxor Temple, which was constructed by King Amenhotep III, Ramses II, and Tutankhamen with other Pharaohs who participated in completing the temple. breakfast and lunch

Day 8: Luxor West Bank Sightseeing Tours

By touring the key attractions on the West Bank of the Nile River today, you can extend your Luxor Tours. The most significant tomb is that which is connected to the boy King Tutankhamun. Next, visit Queen Hatshepsut Temple, who was renowned for her strong personality. Pharaohs of the ancient Egypt New Kingdom created their graves there to protect them from tomb thieves and they believed that they will be resurrected once again in heaven as the sun sets each day in the West and reborn in the East. Keep admiring the enormous statues of Amenhotep III seated in majesty, also referred to as the Colossi of Memnon. After that, you will be moved to a hotel in Hurghada for the night. breakfast and lunch

Day 9: Free Day in Hurghada

Enjoy a delicious breakfast buffet at your Hurghada hotel and a relaxing day on the beach, or select from a variety of <u>Hurghada Tours and Excursions</u>, Enjoy Breakfast, lunch, and dinner
