<u>Itinerary</u>

Day 1: Arrive in Cairo, Egypt

Once you arrive at <u>Cairo International Airport</u>, you will be greeted by an English-speaking tour guide from Cairo Top Tours. They will assist you in transferring to your hotel in Cairo using a comfortable air-conditioned vehicle. Upon arrival at the hotel, you will receive a welcome drink, and the tour guide will guide you through a seamless check-in process and provide you with detailed information about your <u>Egypt Travel Package</u> to know more about your trip.

After a good night's sleep, you will be ready for your early morning tour to visit the famous Pyramids of Egypt.

Day 2: Pyramids and Sphinx Excursion

Once you finish your breakfast, our professional guide will pick you up from the hotel lobby to start your exciting Cairo Day Tour to the <u>Pyramids of Giza</u> and the <u>Sphinx</u>. Day 3: Alexandria Trip

This city was founded by Alexander the Great during the Greco-Roman era and was once known as the most beautiful city in the world. During your visit, you will explore the Greco-Roman sites and the Catacombs of Kom El Shouqafa, as well as the ruins of the Roman temple complex and Pompey's pillar.

One of the top places to visit during our Alexandria Shore Excursions is the <u>Citadel of Qaitbay</u>, which is where the famous lighthouse Pharos used to be (one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World). You will also visit the modern <u>Bibliotheca of Alexandria</u> and enjoy it.

For lunch, you will enjoy fresh, high-quality seafood at a local restaurant. Finally, you will head to your hotel in Alexandria for an overnight stay.

Day 4: Alexandria to Cairo - Train to Aswan

Once you complete the tour of the Egyptian Museum, you will have a delicious lunch in a local restaurant before boarding the train to Aswan. You will be spending the night in your compartment aboard the train.

Day 6: Abu Simbel Temples

These temples were created over 3000 years ago during the reign of Pharaoh <u>Ramesses II</u> and his queen Nefertari. Afterward, you'll return to your hotel in Aswan for the night, with breakfast and lunch included during the day.

Day 7: Aswan to Luxor - Luxor Temple

After starting your day with breakfast at your hotel in Aswan, you'll be taken to Luxor for a day of exploration. Your first stop will be the <u>Temple of Luxor</u>, an impressive structure that was originally built by King Amenhotep III and later completed by Ramesses II. This temple dates back to the New Kingdom era and is a must-see attraction. Afterward, you'll be transported to your hotel in Luxor for the night, with breakfast and lunch provided throughout the day.

Day 8: Karnak Temple - Luxor West Bank - Transfer to Hurghada

Today, you'll have the opportunity to visit the impressive Karnak Temple, which is the largest temple in the world. This temple is dedicated to the important God Amun, his consort the famous Goddess Mut, and their son Khonsu. It was built over many centuries by different Egyptian kings, from the Middle Kingdom to the Graeco-Roman era.

In addition, you'll also get to explore several fascinating monuments on the West bank of the Nile, including the <u>Hatshepsut Temple</u> in Deir Al-Bahary, the <u>Valley of Kings</u>, and the Colossi of Memnon.

Later, you'll embark on a 3-hour land transfer to <u>Hurghada</u>, where you'll spend the night at your hotel. Throughout the day, you'll be provided with breakfast, lunch, and dinner.

Day 9: Submarine Excursion in Hurghada

After breakfast at your hotel in Hurghada, you'll have the opportunity to embark on an incredible underwater adventure on the <u>Sindbad Submarine</u>. This two-hour excursion will take you 22 meters deep below sea level to view a variety of marine life and colorful fish in the Red Sea. You don't need to be a scuba diver to enjoy this experience, as the submarine has a capacity of 44 passengers and is accessible to everyone.

After the excursion, you'll be transported back to your hotel in Hurghada, where you can enjoy breakfast, lunch, and dinner throughout the day.

Day 10: Free Day in Hurghada
