Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival

When you arrive in Egypt, we will be waiting for you at <u>Cairo International Airport</u> to assist you before driving you in an air-conditioned vehicle to your hotel in Cairo.

When you arrive at the hotel, a representative from our company will serve you a welcome drink and assist you with the check-in process. They will also review your itinerary with us.

Cairo overnight stay.

Day 2: Pyramids, Memphis, Sakkara

Enjoy the hotel's breakfast.

You will be transported to the Necropolis of Giza, which is the first place on your itinerary. While there, you'll discover all about ancient Egypt's history.

Our Egypt Easter tours will begin at the <u>Giza pyramids</u>, where you can see the Valley Temple, the Great Sphinx, and the three Great Pyramids. We'll then travel to Memphis.

We'll have the chance to tour Mit-Rahina, a contemporary community that is home to a museum displaying ancient artifacts from Memphis, such as the Alabaster Sphinx, and other exhibits and sarcophagi, such as the enormous tomb of Ramses II.

We'll then go grab a bite to eat at a nearby restaurant after that.

The Sakkara Pyramid will be our final stop before your tour guide returns you to your hotel

Day 3: Egyptian Museum, Old Cairo

On the third day, we will take you to <u>Tahrir Square in Cairo</u>, where we will visit the <u>Egyptian Museum</u>, We will tour the museum's various halls to see the masterpieces it is home to.

We will depart from downtown Cairo and go to a nearby restaurant before continuing on to Old Cairo. We will begin our Islamic exploration there by touring the Mamluk Mosque, Sultan Hassan's Madrasas, and the mosque of Ibn Tulun, which was built more than a thousand years ago and is the oldest stillstanding mosque in Africa.

You will then be driven to <u>Coptic Cairo</u>, You will begin your tour of Cairo in the Coptic neighborhood where you will see the Roman fortress of Babylon, an ancient Roman fortress constructed by Emperor Trajan. Head over to the Hanging Church, which was constructed above the fortress's ruins.

We'll also take you to the Abu Serga Church, which is situated above the Holy Family Cavern, and the <u>Ben Ezra Synagogue</u> in Old Cairo, which is one of Cairo's oldest synagogues and has a fascinating history. Together with your guide, learn more about Coptic Cairo before stopping in Old Cairo for a

Day 4: Citadel, Cairo Tower, Downtown Cairo

We will travel to <u>Salah El Din Citadel</u> after your morning meal. Before going to <u>Cairo Tower</u>, you can explore the architecture of Egyptian buildings from the Islamic Middle Ages and learn all about their history.

After departing the tower, we'll go on a shopping tour of downtown Cairo and eat lunch somewhere local.

Day 5: Mohamed Ali Palace, Garbage City, and Qasr El-Baron

On the fifth day, we'll transfer you to Garbage City after visiting the <u>Mohamed Ali Mosque</u>. the area that is only used for disposal, recycling, and all city waste.

At night, we'll travel to Heliopolis' Baron Palace, a mansion with Indian influences.

Day 6: Transfer to Aswan

After breakfast, you will check out of your hotel in Cairo and transfer to the airport to catch your internal flight to Aswan.

We will help you with the check-in procedures at your Aswan cruise upon arrival, and then we'll go to the <u>High Dam</u>, which is regarded as an engineering marvel because it was constructed in the 1960s and created the largest artificial lake in the world.

You will be taken to the Aswan granite quarries after leaving the high dam, where the ancient Egyptians obtained the durable material they needed to construct their statues, structures, and, most significantly, their obelisks.

then proceed to the magnificent <u>Philae Temple</u>, the epicenter of the worship of Goddess Isis, the island's patron deity.

And At the end of the day, you'll head back to your ship.

Day 7: Kom Ombo, sailing to Edfu Temple

We will travel to the <u>Kom Ombo Temple</u> on the seventh day; it is about 45 kilometers north of Aswan. There, you'll spend the day before setting sail for Edfu.

Day 8: Visit Edfu Temple, and sail to Luxor

We'll arrive at <u>Edfu's Temple of Horus</u> by morning. With the help of your knowledgeable tour guide, you will explore the temple in detail and discover everything there is to know about the <u>Gods and</u> <u>goddesses of ancient Egypt</u>. Of course, you'll be taken back to your cruise ship after your tour is over.

Day 9: Luxor attractions

On the ninth day, you will visit <u>Luxor Temple</u>, which the New Kingdom pharaohs built, before traveling to Luxor to start your exciting day in the <u>Valley of the Kings</u>, In an effort to hide their wealth and protect their mummies, the New Kingdom pharaohs there carved their tombs into the mountains. Your tour guide will explain everything from the outside because there is no inside instruction for the tombs. Explore the top 3 tombs from the ones that are accessible after that. The tombs of King Tutmosis I, King Tutmosis III, Tut-Ankh-Amon, King Ramses VI, King Mrenptah, and Amenhotep II are the ones that are best known.

We will then accompany you and the Colossi of Memnon as you make your way to a nearby restaurant for lunch before returning to your hotel.

Day 10: Transfer to Cairo

Before boarding your domestic flight back to Cairo in the morning, you will have the opportunity to disembark from your cruise.

Day 11: White desert day tour

After breakfast, our tour guide will meet you at your hotel and drive you to the beginning of our <u>Egypt</u> <u>day tour</u> trip through the <u>White Desert</u> in an air-conditioned private vehicle.

You will discover the beauty of views of sand dunes, as well as limestone rock formations, white chalk, and their fossils. and then you'll take a break for lunch once you've finished exploring this wonderful area.
