Day 1: Arrival in Cairo

When you arrive at <u>Cairo International Airport</u>, our representative will be there to greet you with a sign bearing your name and be available to help you with any procedures as you start your trip to Egypt. by way of the airport.

It took more than 20 years to construct and contains more than 2.3 million stone blocks.

The Despite being the smallest of the three pyramids, the Pyramid of Menkaure represents an important architectural feat. It served as Menkaure's tomb when it was constructed.

The Museum of Egyptian Antiquities, also known as the Egyptian Museum, is the next place you'll want to visit.
