Itinerary Day 1: Arrive to Cairo Egypt

Upon arrival at [Cairo International Airport](#), you'll be picked up by our representative and transferred to your hotel in Cairo or Giza. Once you arrive at the hotel, you'll be served a welcome drink, and our representative will review the itinerary of your 9-day Egypt Easter tour to confirm that everything is going according to plan. They'll also assist you with a smooth check-in process.

You'll spend the night in Cairo before starting your adventure, exploring the beautiful country of Egypt.

Day 2: Giza Pyramids, Saqqara Necropolis Tour

After enjoying your breakfast, you'll embark on a fascinating tour of ancient Egyptian landmarks with an expert guide. Your first stop will be the Giza Pyramids, including the Great Pyramid of Cheops, the Pyramid of Chephren, and the Pyramid of Mycerinus. You'll also visit the Great Sphinx and the [Valley Temple of King Chephren](#), where his royal corpse was mummified.

Your [Cairo day tours](#) will continue to Saqqara, where you'll see the [Step Pyramid](#) of King Djoser, built with six steps, one on top of the other. You'll also enter the Pyramid of Teti and the tomb of Kagemni to see impressive daily life scenes carved in perfection.

After a delicious lunch at a top-notch restaurant, you'll have the rest of the day to explore Cairo on one of our [Egypt day tours](#) or take a break at the hotel. Our professional tour guide will help you learn more about the monuments and answer any questions you may have. We'll make sure to take good care of you during your trip.

Day 3: Fly to Aswan, Aswan tour

After checking out of your hotel, you'll catch your flight to Aswan and check in to our 5-star [Egypt Nile cruise from Aswan](#) to Luxor. Once you've had some time to rest, your Aswan excursions will begin with a visit to the Aswan High Dam, where your guide will explain how its construction and the subsequent creation of Lake Nasser required the transfer of the Nubian people and some important historical monuments, including the Abu Simbel Temples, which you'll have a chance to explore the following day.

You'll then take a short boat ride to the Island of Agilkia to visit the [Temple of Philae](#). This temple was built during the Ptolemaic era (305 B.C. to 30 B.C.) and is dedicated to Goddess Isis, one of the oldest deities of ancient Egypt. You'll continue to the granite quarries to see the [Unfinished Obelisk](#), which is believed to have been cut during the reign of the famous Queen Hatshepsut.

After the tour, you'll return to the cruise and spend the night aboard in Aswan.

Day 4: Kom Ombo and Edfu Temples trip

You'll start your day with an optional excursion to the Abu Simbel Temples from Aswan, which are two impressive temples located in southern Egypt and a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Known as the "Nubian

Monument," these temples were carved out of the mountainside during the reign of Pharaoh Ramses II in the 18th dynasty of the new kingdom. After visiting Abu Simbel, the tour will continue with a visit to the [Kom Ombo Temple](#), which is a double temple dedicated to the crocodile god Sobek and the falcon god Haroeris (Horus).

After exploring Kom Ombo Temple, you'll head towards [Edfu](#) to visit the temple dedicated to Horus, who was the protector of kingship. This temple is over 2,000 years old, but it was covered in sand until it was rediscovered by the French expedition in 1798. Due to being hidden for so long, it is the best-preserved temple in Egypt.

You'll then continue sailing to Luxor, where you'll spend the night.

Day 5: Luxor West Bank Trips

Your first destination on this day will be the famous Valley of the Kings, where you'll have the opportunity to enter some of the incredible tombs of the Pharaohs of the New Kingdom, including the tomb of King Tutankhamun. You'll then have a fabulous tour of the Temple of Hatshepsut (El Deir El Bahari Temple), which was the mortuary temple of the first queen in [Ancient Egyptian History](#) who ruled during the New Kingdom.

The day will end with a visit to the great [Colossi of Memnon](#), which are the last remains of the temple of Amenophis III. After the tour, you'll head back to the cruise ship and spend the night onboard.

Day 6: Luxor East Bank Trips

On this day, your adventure will begin by visiting the [East Bank of Luxor tours](#) and exploring the complex of Karnak, which was part of the ancient city of Thebes. This complex is dedicated to the powerful ram-headed god Amun and includes a vast mix of temples, chapels, statues, and obelisks.

Next, you'll explore the temple of Luxor, which is connected to the [Karnak Temple](#) by a long avenue of sphinxes. This temple is dedicated to the triad of Amun, his wife Mut, and his son Khonso and played a major role in the great Opet Festival held every year during the flood season.

After the tour, you'll take a private, air-conditioned vehicle to Hurghada on the Red Sea coast, where you'll stay in an all-inclusive resort.

Day 7: Optional Snorkeling Tour in Hurghada

This day is all yours to spend as you wish. You can relax and unwind by swimming in the pool or lying on the sandy beach, all while enjoying all-inclusive food and beverages. It's the perfect opportunity for total relaxation!

Alternatively, you can choose to participate in any of the water sports activities, including our impressive Hurghada snorkeling tours and scuba diving.
